

AFRALO ACTIVITY REPORT - MAY 2013

AFRALO's main activities of May 2013 are following:

1. The At-Large Summit ATLAS II

A working group "The At-Large Summit II Working Group (ATLAS II)" was established for the project of the Organization of the At-Large Summit on the occasion of the 51st ICANN meeting to be held in London in June 2014. 2. Virtual capacity building program for African ALS

In preparation for the At Large Summit and as a result of the training sessions organized by AFRALO in Dakar, three virtual training sessions will be organised by AFRALO with the assistance of the staff, for the benefit of African ALS. The first training session will take place Thursday, June 11, 2013 at 18:00 UTC. Two presentations are planned in the program. A presentation on the missions of ICANN, its structure and its components by Pierre Dandjinou and a second presentation on the role of the ALAC and the At-Large community, by Olivier Crépin-Leblond.

3. Activities planned for the July meeting in Durban,

As a result of the appeal launched by Afralo members to submit proposals for activities to organize in Durban, it was decided to organize an Afralo Show-Case, activities for the benefit of the local population in South Africa from the universities, schools and organizations that represent end users of the Internet. The goal is to give 20 people the opportunity to participate in the activities of ICANN; they will be offered the possibility of:

- To participate actively in the Show Case that AFRALO intends to organize.
- To attend meetings of the ALAC, see how it works and how t ICANN multi-stakeholder model runs,

4. Theme of the joint AFRALO - AfrICANN in Durban

Continuing the tradition that AFRALO implemented from Brussels and which consists of a meeting for the whole of the African community present at the meetings of ICANN, AFRALO again, launched an online consultation to set the theme to be discussed at the next joint AFRALO - AfrICANN in Durban.

5. AFRALO Activities at the IGF 2013 in BALI

The 2013 edition of (IGF) Internet Governance Forum will take place in Bali in Indonesia this year from 22 to 25 October 2013. A workshop developed and proposed by Afralo program was submitted to the Forum on Internet governance (IGF). The theme focuses on ***"How the Internet can be an engine for growth and development"***.
