ALAC COMMENT ON SAC054: DOMAIN NAME REGISTRATION DATA MODEL

SAC054, released on 11 June 2012, proposes a standards-based, structured, and extensible model for the recording of Domain Name Registration Data. (DNRD). This DNRD Model is presented as a candidate or strawman for Community discussion and as a basis for further development. The SSAC seeks Community feedback on its completeness and utility.

The ALAC commends SSAC for this initiative and supports its intent. Jim Galvin (Deputy Chair of SSAC) briefed At-Large Community Members on SAC054 during a Webinar on 20 July 2012 and the following points were noted during discussion:

- The data model should include elements that could be used for privacy controls.
- It would be useful for SAC054 to be translated into other languages, in particular Spanish and French.

Spanish and French translations have subsequently been done and these are posted on the <u>At-Large Policy Development Page</u>. These translations have not yet been posted on the <u>SSAC Documents Page</u> (as at 23rd August 2012).

No further comment on SAC054 has been received from At-Large Community Members. However, the ALAC will be interested to review future iterations of the Domain Name Registration Model as it evolves.
