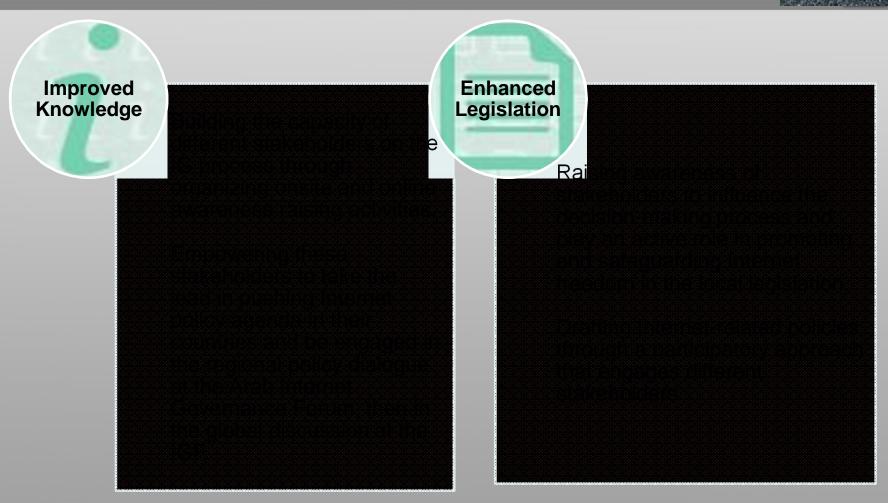

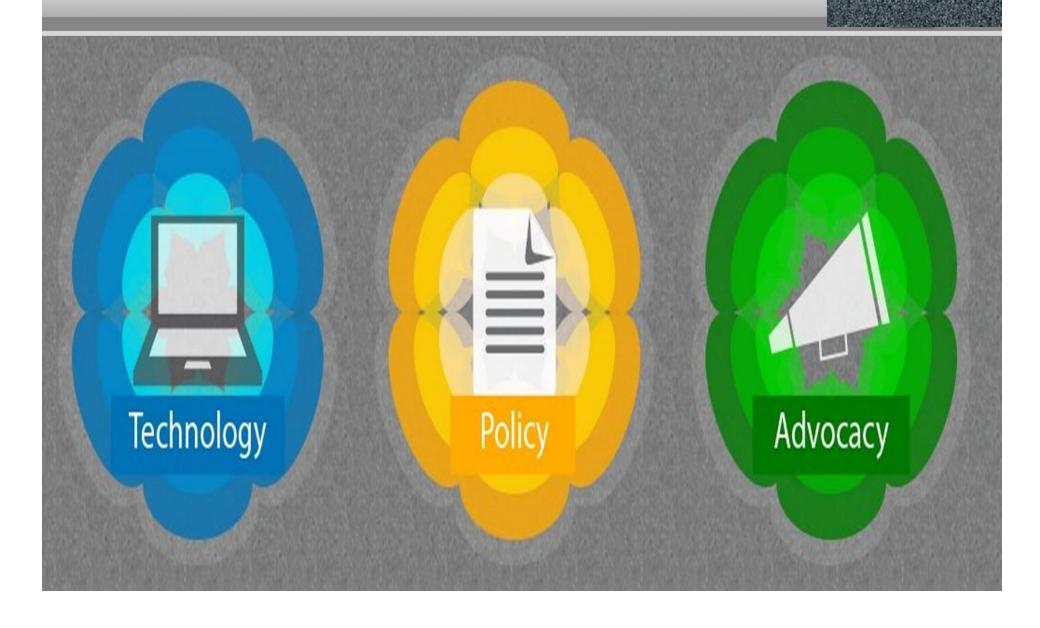

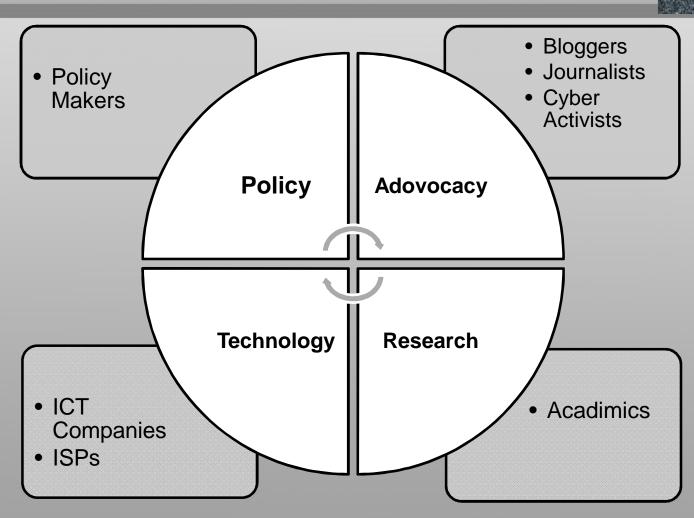
Pillars Dimension of IGMENA Program

Empowers authors as leaders to promote their ideas on a range of issues, on online freedom of expression, data protection and privacy, censorship and surveillance.

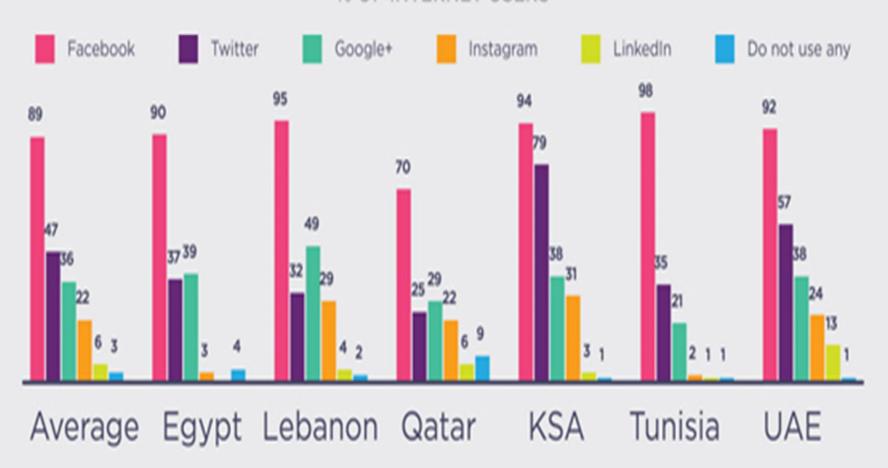


IPA Vector

- The project will initially cover five countries: Syria, Egypt, Tunisia, Jordan and Iraq and will expand at a later stage to include more countries from the region.

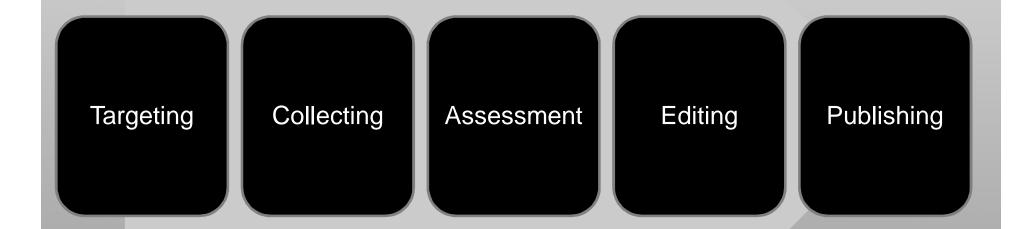
