Ashley Heineman (GAC): (11:06) Hi Kavouss... the word "purpose" in this sense is a specific reference in the GDPR.

Kavouss Arasteh (GAC) 2: (11:11) Please replace the term " PURPOSE" by other terms which reflect what we expecting that ICANN , Registry, or Registrar should do.

Kavouss Arasteh (GAC) 2: (11:12) As for third party there is not relevance of what they may expect the their purpose. I do not understand the meaning of " Third Party Purpose"

Thomas Rickert (ISPCP): (11:12) Kavouss, we have been working on the purpose matrix for hours and hours, so I am surprised you are concerned about the use of the word. We have to specify who is pursuing what purposes, so ICANN purposes are the ones pursued by ICANN. This is part of the legal tests we conduct. Please, let us agree to use the words as in the law.

Kavouss Arasteh (GAC) 2: (11:13) I have no problem with the works you have done as I fully appreciate that but pls do not label them as "PURPOSE"

Kavouss Arasteh (GAC) 2: (11:15) I STRONGLY SUPPORT THE USE OF OR REFERENCE TO ACCURACY

Kavouss Arasteh (GAC) 2: (11:16) PLS KINDLY INDICATE WHY WE CAN NOT ADDRESS THE QUESTION OF ACCURACY OR ADDITIONAL ACCURACY

Milton Mueller (NCSG): (11:21) Accuracy under GDPR means a data subject's ability to correct inaccurate data. It does not mean "verification"

Milton Mueller (NCSG): (11:22) So if people are going to use this "accuracy" question to try to write new policies regarding verification I will oppose any addition of this question

Thomas Rickert (ISPCP): (11:28) We have agreed on a compromise yesterday containing three points: 1. Amend language of the purpose (we did that). 2. Add a disclaimer that none of ICANN's accuracy requirements will be impaired and 3. that this does not preclude any further debate on accuracy. Can we stick to this agreement? We can discuss the wish for additional accuracy requirements, but let us PLEASE work on the purposes on the list. We will get nowhere if we get distracted now.

Georgios Tselentis (GAC): (11:30) I do not break the agreement Thomas. I put the debate on the spreadsheet under discussion. I cannot understand why we discuss 5.1.c regarding retention in the data analysis of the GDPR and not 5.1.d

Milton Mueller (NCSG): (11:36) Georgios: you're getting pushback because you're not interested in mapping purposes to data elements and legal bases but are pushing a policy agenda, or so it seems to us.

Thomas Rickert (ISPCP): (11:36) Georgios, I think that 5.1.d as a general principle is not related to a specific purpose, but - as data security and other GDPR requirements - relevant to all purposes. Data retention, however, might differ from data element to data element. Hence the distinction.
