- To allow for skill building and knowledge sharing among ccTLDs

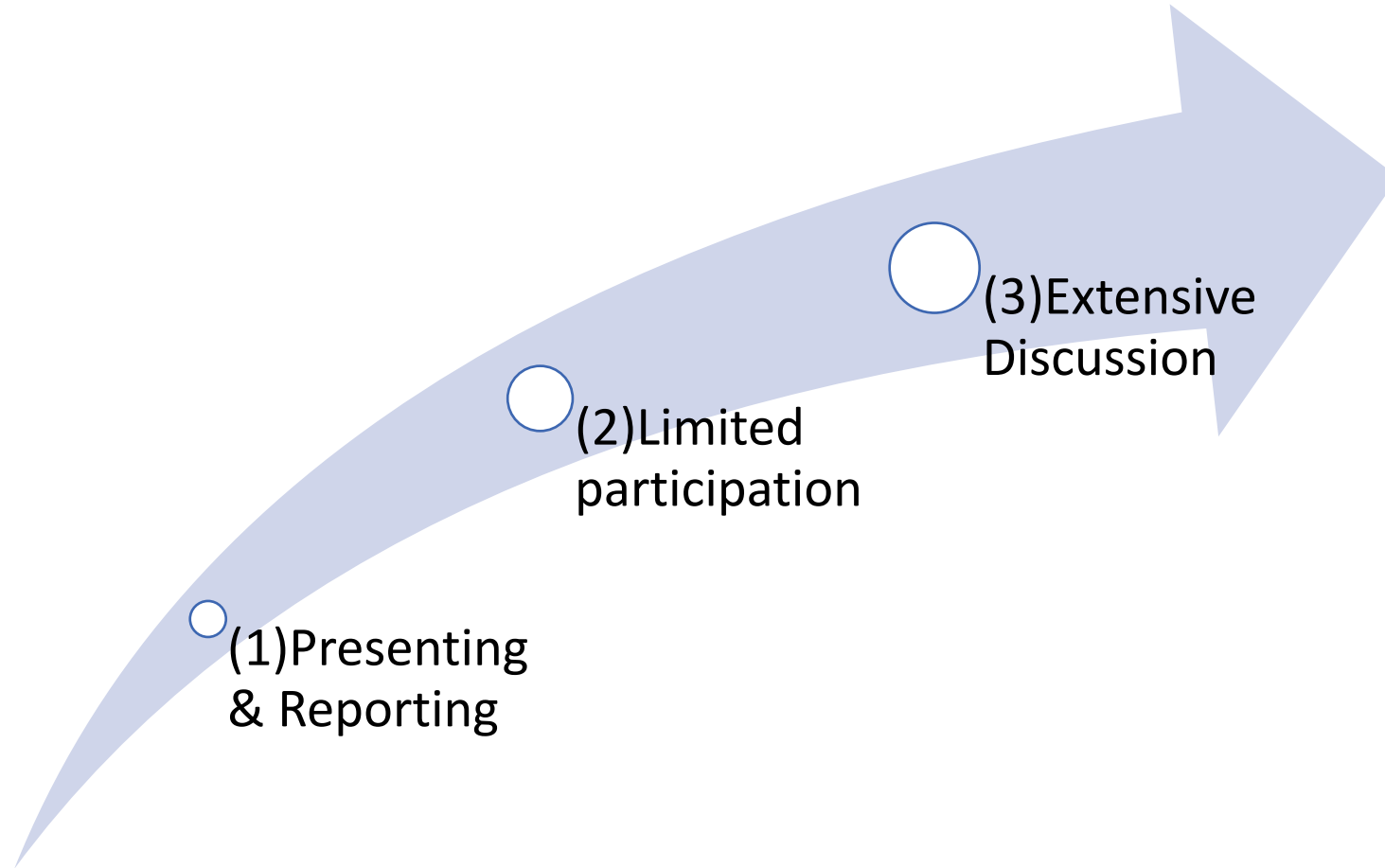
# ccNSO members meeting: layout

# Levels of involvement

Each level of involvement exponentially increases:

- the levels of participation by the audience
- the role for the session chair.



# ! Important !

- Plan the appropriate level of involvement well in advance
- Allow for appropriate amount of time for dialogue
- Respect the deadlines by ICANN's meeting team

# Tips & tricks: increase the level of involvement (1)

## Questions

- The speaker opens with a question
- Allow for questions from the audience throughout the presentation
- The audience can type questions in the AC chat
- Do an inverse Q&A
- Have people vet the questions in groups
- Ask for reactions, do not only ask for questions
- Share a final story after the Q&A

## Measure the temperature

- Show of cards
- Vote with your feet
- Inverse Q&A
