REQUEST DESCRIPTION

1. Activity: Please describe your proposed activity in detail

The objective of this request is to make develop and implement a series of workshops, online modules, including webinars and ICANN Learn, and one f2f at the Southern School of Internet Governance (SSIG), targeted at each of the sub-regions focusing on 4 global issues under discussion within ICANN to facilitate their engagement in policy advice development.

This activity is in direct reference to the At-Large Review Implementation that focuses on greater involvement of members in ICANN policy and policy advice development.

It also will reference the LAC Strategy being implemented by GSE.

ICANN GSE will work together with At-Large staff and LACRALO members to implement this activity if approved. More detailed planning will occur once the activity is approved.

The topics will be presented by members of the At-Large Community (5 RALOs), orienting the entire community of the Latin American and Caribbean region that has not yet been involved in ICANN or in Internet Governance issues.

The online courses and webinars will be implemented in the weeks prior to the Southern School of Internet Governance to be held in 2020. The f2f workshop is planned to be implemented two days prior to this prestigious event in Latin America.

Each ALS will be asked to try to set up a remote hub within their universities or organizations to participate remotely in the online and f2f sessions.

We are requesting support for travel, accommodation and per diem for a minimum of 4 speakers who might need to travel to location of the SSIG.

2. Type of Activity: e.g. Outreach - Education/training - Travel support - Research/Study - Meetings - Other

A series of training modules to increase the engagement of Latin American and Caribbean At-Large members and potential members.

These modules will focus on education/awareness raising and skill development.

A website and or wiki page and Eventbrite registration page will be developed as part of process of registering participants, repository of materials and historical reference.

3. Proposed Timeline/Schedule: e.g. one time activity, recurring activity

FY20, including around the time of the School of the South Internet Governance. The online version will take place prior to the conference. The f2f workshop will take place two days before the initiation of School of the South Internet Governance

3. Deliverables. What are the desired outcomes of your proposed activity?				

Enhance the understanding and knowledge of ICANN Policy issues and broader Internet Governance issues within the ICANN Latin American and Caribbean Region. Provide the opportunity for ICANN to engage a targeted audience from the At-Large Community and broader Latin American and Caribbean community by encouraging them to learn more about ICANN and the multi-stakeholder model.

Prepare in-depth online capacity building webinars and ICANN Learn courses as well as at least one f2f workshop based on the needs identifies during the event. A user survey will be used to determine these.

Creation of a webpage on the At-Large website and or wiki page, Facebook page and Eventbrite registration pages.

Social media strategy to promote and share event content to #ICANN #ATLARGE #LACRALO.

4. *Metrics.* What measurements will you use to determine whether your activity achieves its desired outcomes?

Expect to engage a minimum of 10% of all participants (on line and presence) in further IG discussions. This is to be measured through the web site activity and number of subscribers to the page and new requests to involved in LACRALO.

We expect this initiative to be duplicated and enhanced for subsequent years.
