Since the last update, the project is moving slightly ahead of schedule. Following informal discussions between the Committee and the Root Server System Advisory Committee (RSSAC), the Concept Paper was revised to ensure accuracy and consistency. Based on the Concept Paper, a set of operating procedures, a work plan and a charter were created for the Root Server System Governance Working Group. This Working Group is tasked with taking the Concept Paper and advice from RSSAC to develop the final governance model. The next phase of the work will involve costing all of the work associated with implementing the model, setting up the functions and running and maintaining the model that the Working Group develops. Any changes that result from the evolving root server system will be handled through established ICANN processes to ensure accountability and transparency. The RSSAC will con
