NEW: ICANN Publishes New Report on Domain Registrations Related to COVID-19

ICANN is pleased to announce the publication of a new report, [Registrations Related to COVID-19: 18 Months of Data](#) through its Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO). The report outlines one of ICANN's many efforts to keep the Domain Name System (DNS) secure, stable, and resilient. The report

found that, depending on the strength of evidence required, between 1.8% to 6.1% of domains examined could be involved with phishing or malware.
