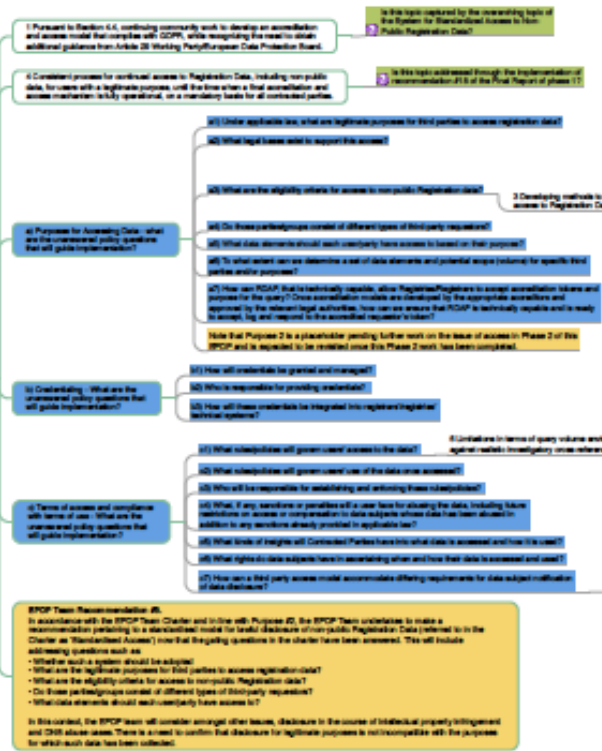
Mind map on next slide reflects charter topics / questions in relation to System for Standardized Access (blue), annex to the temporary specification (white) and phase 1 items (yellow)

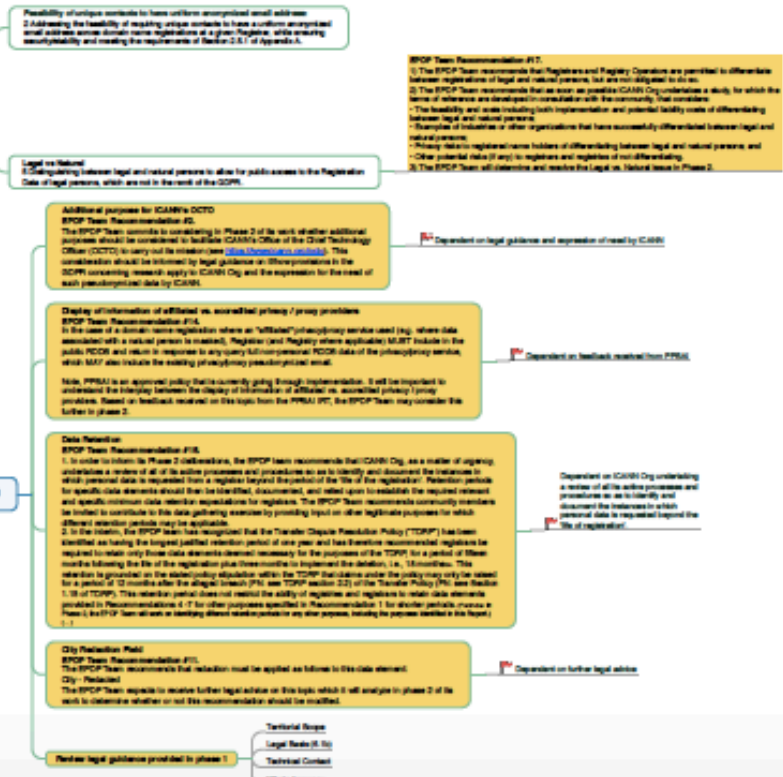
System for Standardized Access to Non-Public Registration Data
(this condition is copied from EPDP Team Charter)



The EPDP Team requested when the EPDP Team commences its deliberations on a identified access framework, a representative of the RPAs/ICANN shall provide an update on the current status of deliberations to the EPDP Team. The EPDP Team may determine how the ICANN recommendations may affect coordination of the UPB and LDDP to the content of the standardized access framework deliberations.

Annex: Important Issues for Further Community Action



EPDP Team Recommendation #17.
1. The EPDP Team recommends that Registrars and Registry Operators are permitted to differentiate between requests of legal and natural persons, but are not obliged to do so.
2. The EPDP Team recommends that as soon as possible ICANN Org undertake a study, for which the goal of reference are developed in consultation with the community, that considers:
- The feasibility and costs including both implementation and potential liability costs of differentiating between legal and natural persons.
- Examples of industries or other organizations that have successfully differentiated between legal and natural persons.
- Strongly identifying legal and natural holders of information between legal and natural persons, and
- Other potential risks (if any) to registries and registrars of not differentiating.
3. The EPDP Team will determine and resolve the Legal vs. National Issue in Phase 2.

Dependent on feedback received from PPRM

Dependent on ICANN Org undertaking a review of all its active processes and procedures so as to identify and document the instances in which personal data is requested beyond the file of registration.

System for Standardized Access to Non-Public Registration Data

- ⦿ Number of questions identified in the EPDP Team Charter concerning purposes for accessing data, credentialing and terms of access / compliance with terms of use.

- ⦿ See also Phase 1 Rec #3 questions:
 - Whether such a system should be adopted
 - What are the legitimate purposes for third parties to access registration data?
 - What are the eligibility criteria for access to non-public Registration data?
 - Do those parties/groups consist of different types of third-party requestors?
 - What data elements should each user/party have access to?

- ⦿ Intersection with work of ICANN Org and Technical Study Group on Unified Access Model (UAM)

Temp Spec Annex – Important Issues

- ⦿ Continuing community work to develop an accreditation and access model that complies with GDPR, recognizing the need to obtain additional guidance from EDPB
- ⦿ Feasibility of requiring unique contacts to have a uniform anonymized email address across domain name registrations, while ensuring security / stability
- ⦿ Develop methods to provide potential URS and UDRP complainants with sufficient access to support good faith filing of complaints (see also phase 1 request to get update from RPM WG)
- ⦿ Consistent process for continued access, including non-public data, for users with a legitimate purpose, until a final mechanism is fully operational, on a mandatory basis for all contracted parties
- ⦿ Distinguishing between legal and natural persons (see also rec #17)
- ⦿ Limitations in terms of query volume
- ⦿ Confidentiality of queries by LE authorities

Items Deferred from Phase 1

- ⦿ Recommendation #2 – Additional Purpose for OCTO Research
- ⦿ Recommendation #14 – Privacy / Proxy Registrations
- ⦿ Recommendation #15 – Data Retention
- ⦿ Recommendation #11 – City Redaction
- ⦿ Recommendation #17 – Legal / Natural

Note, all these items are dependent on external input to be provided, either from legal counsel, ICANN Org or another group (i.e. PPSAI IRT)
