Oversight

In **business**, **oversight** of a system or process **is** the responsibility for making sure that it works efficiently and correctly.

LAW, GOVERNMENT, MANAGEMENT <u>systems</u> or <u>actions</u> to <u>control</u> an <u>activity</u> and make <u>sure</u> that it is done <u>correctly</u> and <u>legally</u>

Observation: the more the ICANN Board is involved in the operations, the lesser it is available for oversight

Disadvantages of having ICANN Board involved: responsibility of IFO. Board decisions can be harder un-done than PTI decisions.
