

# ATLAS III EOI Form - Expression of Interest to be considered as a Supported Traveller to attend the ATLAS III Meeting during ICANN 66 in Montreal Canada (2-7 Nov 2019)

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Submission of this Expression of Interest Form (EOI Form) indicates that you are registering your interest and intent to be considered for Constituency Travel Support to attend the 2019 ATLAS III Meeting as a supported traveller/participant.
2. This is a competitive process whereby up to 60 supported travellers (across all 5 RALOs) will be selected based on:
  - 1) meeting a set of required criteria listed in the form and
  - 2) an assessment of any desirable and declared attributes, skills sets, and experiences you include on this form
3. EOI Forms will be evaluated by a Regionally-balanced Selection Committee (a 5 member group with a representative from each Geographic Region or RALO in At-Large).
4. The Selection Committee will evaluate all applications. The Selection Committee may not be able to speak Spanish or French, therefore all online EOI Forms must be completed on the ENGLISH (EN) version. There are only a few questions where the form asks you to write in words - all the other questions ask for responses by way of tickboxes or radio buttons. We are happy to have you write in Spanish or French. These will be translated (as needed) using the Google Translate Extension tool for the Selection Committee as they do their evaluations.
5. French and Spanish translations of the EOI Form can be found as a PDF/Word doc on the ATLAS III Wiki page. Please refer to the translated documents, if needed, as you complete your EOI Form online. Also please seek assistance from your RALO Leaders and or someone you know from your region who can help you to complete the EOI Form.
6. Please use a valid email address for your submission as a copy of it will be sent to you at that email address. After you complete your EOI Form and submit it, you will be able to revisit and edit or update your original submission right up until when the application window closes at 23:59 UTC on 31 May 2019. This will be important as you complete the Required ICANN Learn Courses or Live Webinars over the next few weeks (see Section 4 for further details).
