# Subsequent Procedures

- No Rush!
- Priority to Communities and Underserved Regions (incl. IDN regions)
- Get it right this time!
  - Implement CCT, RPM and SSR2 Recommendations
  - Listen to SSAC concerns
  - Don't leave everything for staff implementation

# Geographic Names – A Work in Progress

- Should minimize end user confusion
- Should prioritize indigenous communities for non-generic, region specific uses
- Still working on consensus on the rest

# Auction Proceeds

- Should be consistent with ICANN mission/remit
- Individuals and ALSs should be able to apply for grants

# GDPR Implementation – EPDP Phase II

- Access by Legitimate Actors is the TOP PRIORITY
- Should try to revisit geographic distinction for “disclosure”
- Should try to revisit Legal/Natural Distinction for “disclosure”
- True Costs of Distinctions should be subject to Independent Study

# Evolution of the Multi-stakeholder Model

- Structural Issues Still Exist
- But ALAC specifically supports...
  - strengthening security of the DNS and the DNS Root Server System
  - evolving the DNS to better serve the needs of the global users
  - ensuring ICANN's long-term financial sustainability
  - Encouraging participation by the broadest community of voices
