## Implementation Project Team (IPT) Role

- 1. ICANN org program director will build and lead the IPT and IRT to implement the policy.
- 2. IPT will design and build an implementation plan for IRT review and subsequently for public comment.
- 3. IPT will set clear expectations and deadlines for IRT feedback on the implementation plan.
- 4. IPT will provide regular status updates and share relevant material with the IRT
- 5. IPT in coordination with the IRT will conduct appropriate outreach to the community at critical milestones.
- IPT will schedule IRT meetings and distribute agenda and relevant documents at least 24 hours prior to each meeting.
- 7. IPT will publish work products on the IRT wiki space.



## Implementation Review Team (IRT) Role

- IRT shall operate in accordance with the <u>IRT Principles and</u> <u>Guidelines</u>.
- IRT is not a policymaking body and shall not engage in discussions to alter recommendations to be implemented.
- 3. IRT is convened to assist the IPT in implementation of the policy consistent with the Board approved recommendations.
- 4. IRT members need a good understanding of the contents of the Board resolution and the Final Report.
- 5. IRT members are expected to attend and actively participate in meetings.
- 6. IRT members should provide feedback/answer questions within deadlines requested by the IPT or communicate with the IPT if additional time is required.
- 7. IRT members must have a current Statement of Interest.

- The Board resolved on 15 May 2019: Consideration of GNSO EPDP Recommendations on the Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data

- 11 Resolutions:(2019.05.15.02) to (2019.05.15.12)
- 27 of 29 recommendations adopted without change
- Two recommendations adopted with changes:
  - Recommendation 1: Purposes #2
  - Recommendation 12: Org field deletion
- Three categories in the Scorecard
  - A: Recommendations adopted as is
  - B: Recommendations adopted with comments
  - C: Recommendation not adopted in whole




## The Interim Registration Data Policy

- Published on 17 May 2019: Interim Registration
   Data Policy for gTLDs:

- Effective 20 May 2019, contracted parties must continue to implement measures consistent with the <u>Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data</u> (Temporary Specification), as adopted by the ICANN Board on 17 May 2018.
- Temp Spec expired on 20 May 2019.

#### Implementation Timeline Discussion

#### Factors driving the implementation timeline

- 1. Recommendation 28: the effective date of the gTLD Registration Data Policy shall be February 29, 2020.
- 2. Typical 6 Months Policy Change Cycle: effective date will be at least 6 months after the announcement; exceptions for special cases. <a href="https://www.icann.org/en/system/files/files/gdd-policy-change-calendar-13may15-en.pdf">https://www.icann.org/en/system/files/files/gdd-policy-change-calendar-13may15-en.pdf</a>
- 3. 40-day Public Comment period and the Summary and Analysis Report following the comment period
- 4. Stacking up these defaults means we need to have completed the implementation plan already.
- 5. We'll need to work together to find "expedited" implementation process.
