- Time available: 5 minutes

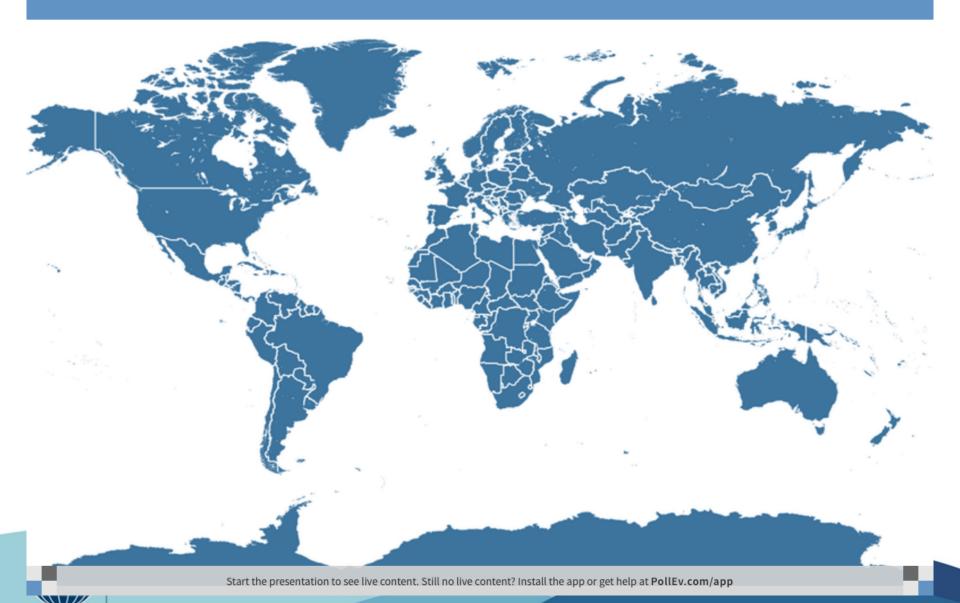

Additional Icebreaker Ideas

- Line up alphabetically by ccTLD name
- Line up by number of years as a ccNSO member
- Find a partner near you (ideally not your colleague or friend) and ask each other:
 - "If you could know the answer to one thing, what would it be?"
 - "What is your most memorable experience from the ccNSO or as a ccTLD manager?"
 - "What is one question you would like to ask...[an astronaut, your favorite author/artist, the top expert in your field]?"

Ideas for MPC | Inputs

- Offer 15-minutes of rapid-fire Q&A sessions to allow people to raise topics of interest or questions they may have that could spark a conversation following the meeting.
- Use mailing list to poll/collect expressions of interest on topics affecting ccTLDs and orient part of the Members' Day meetings to address those high-interest and timely topics.
- Use polling software to collect ideas, feedback, generate discussion (beyond the color cards for gauging temperature of the room), which may help to engage people more actively.



Ideas for MPC | Example Qs

MPC prepares a 2-question survey to inform next Members Day meeting sessions. For example:

- For each ccNSO Work Group/Committee Chair/Co-Chair:
 - What is the biggest issue your WG/C is facing right now?
 - What input would be helpful from the ccTLD community to help you address it?
- For all ccNSO members:
 - What is the biggest question/challenge your ccTLD is facing right now?
 - What information would be helpful from the ccTLD community to help you address it?
 - What is THE MOST timely/important issue for the members to discuss at the subsequent meeting?



Ideas for MPC | Program Ideas

- For the third meeting of the year, reserve the second ccNSO Members' Day meeting for different programming such as:
 - Cross-community sessions. For instance, ccNSOhosted workshops for GNSO colleagues to learn about policies and legal initiatives used by ccTLDs that could inform best practices for gTLDs
 - Use a similar format to Tech Day but for Policy, Legal, or Communications discussions, which are also important topics for ccTLDs to exchange knowledge, perhaps informed by a poll in advance of planning for Tech Day to collect community input on timely topics for discussion.



Ideas for MPC | Capacity Building

Continuing Purpose – Community of Practice & Knowledge Exchange

- Capacity building and training for newer, lesserdeveloped, and/or smaller ccTLDs was also identified as a key role the ccNSO could expand upon. Specifically, this could include:
 - Using meeting time for participatory exchange in addition to the conference-format presentations and discussion. For example, the capacity building sessions at the ccNSO Meeting at ICANN47 in Durban, 2013.



Reverse-Engineering Design

Define Goal/Objective of session, then consider process options to achieve it.

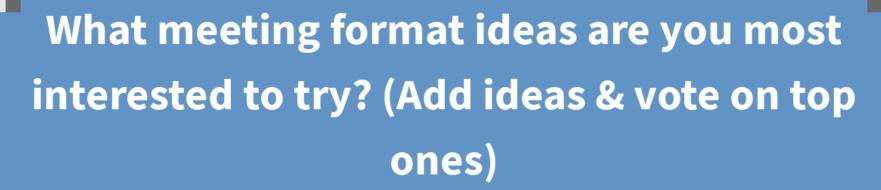
