The SSR2 Review Team undertook the following during this session:

1. Welcome, roll call, SOI updates

Russ noted that staff provided the leadership team with a technical writer candidate resume last week. He noted that the leadership team asked staff to proceed with contracting with this candidate, who will not be in Marrakech. Jennifer confirmed that staff is moving forward with contracting and will advise the team as the steps in the process are completed.
