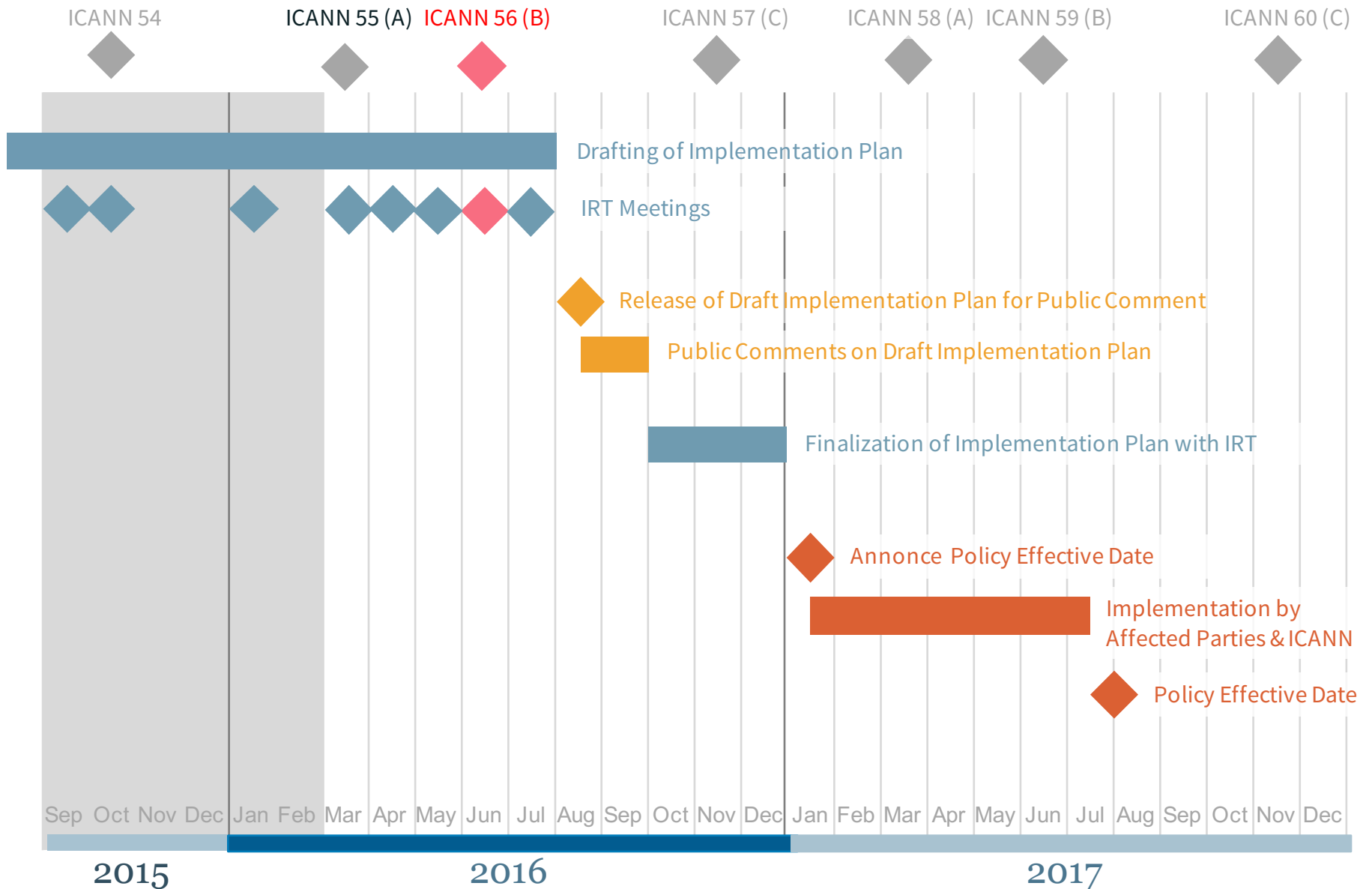

Required for Key Milestones

- ⦿ **Implementation Plan Release for Public Comment (Target Aug 2016)**
 1. Draft Consensus Policy Language
 2. [Agreement with UNDESA for ECOSOC list](#)
 3. 90-day claims solution defined
 4. IGO, IOC, RCRC list update process defined

- ⦿ **Announce Policy Effective Date (February 2017)**
 1. Final Consensus Policy Language
 2. [IGO list: up to two language from GAC](#)
 3. Claims system developed
 4. ECOSOC List with Contact Info
 5. IOC List
 6. Red Cross List
 7. Implementation Notes for Registries

- ⦿ **Policy Effective Date (6 months from announcement)**
 1. The Policy Document
 2. Claims system operational

Status of Implementation Plan

- ⊙ **Consensus Policy**
 - Draft Consensus Policy Language
 - Version 4 in development: list update process
- ⊙ **Implementation Procedures**
 - Top-level reservation and exception procedure – Complete
 - 2nd Level reservation and exception procedure – Complete
 - 2nd Level 90-claims implementation – In design
- ⊙ **Lists of Identifier Labels & other pre-requisite for implementation**
 - RCRC Scope 1 identifiers – Complete
 - IOC identifiers – Complete
 - IGOs Scope 1 identifiers – seeking “up to two languages”
 - INGOs identifiers – received ECOSOC list from UNDESA
 - INGOs Contact Data – received from UNDESA

INGOs Identifiers Labels and Contact Data

Reminder of Policy Recommendation Scope (PDP Final Report §3.4)

- ⦿ Scope 1 Identifiers: [ECOSOC List](#) (General Consultative Status) (Language: English only)
- ⦿ Scope 2 Identifiers: [ECOSOC List](#) (Special Consultative Status) (Language: English only)

Implementation

- ⦿ Labels will be listed in an authoritative document (TBD) to serve implementation of protection at the Top Level (ineligible for delegation) and at the 2nd Level (90-day Claims)

Implementation Challenges/Progress

- ⦿ ICANN Staff established contact with UNDESA CSO Net (ECOSOC list manager)
- ⦿ We received the ECOSOC list with contract information in Excel format
- ⦿ Drafted a MoU detailing the use of the data and update; currently in IPT review
- ⦿ Next steps: Conference with USDESA to discuss the agreement to be documented then follow up with the MoU

INGOs Identifiers: ECOSOC List

- ⦿ Total 3582 identifiers on the list
- ⦿ 144 are of General Consultative status
- ⦿ Information received include:
 - Official name
 - English name if official name isn't in English
 - Address
 - Phone
 - Email
 - Fax
 - URL
 - Consultative status

INGOs Identifiers implementation plan

- ⦿ Sample “Official Names” from the list
 - AARP
 - AVSI Foundation
 - ANAJA (L'Eternel a répondu)
 - Association for Progressive Communications (APC)
 - CIVICUS – World Alliance for Citizen Participation
 - Institut international pour la paix, la justice et les droits de l'Homme- IIPJDH
 - International Association “Znanie”
 - Corporacion Colombia Unida por el Respeto al Adulto Mayor (COR PRO ADULTO MAYOR) / Corporation Colombia United for the Respect of the Elder
- ⦿ Implementation plan:
 - Use the names exactly as provided by UNDESA
 - No ICANN evaluation, adjustment or normalization
 - Treat ECOSOC list received as the authoritative list

Maintenance of the Lists

- ◎ INGO
 - List Authority: ECOSOC List – UNDESA
 - Annual updated list provided by UNDESA to ICANN
 - ICANN provides the updated list to Claims system
- ◎ IGO
 - List Authority: GAC
 - GAC may provide updated list “time to time” per policy recommendation
 - ICANN updates the reservation list upon receipt
- ◎ RCRC
 - No policy recommendation language received regarding updates
 - Follow the same process as IGO
- ◎ IOC
 - No policy recommendation language received regarding updates
 - Follow the same process as IGO

IGO Scope 1 Identifiers Labels

Reminder of Policy Recommendation Scope (PDP Final Report §3.3)

- ⦿ Scope 1 Identifiers: [GAC List \(22 March 2013\)](#) - Full Name (Up to two languages)
- ⦿ Protected at the top-level (ineligible for delegation)
- ⦿ Protected at the 2nd level (reservation with exception procedure)

Implementation

- ⦿ Labels will be listed on the Reserved Names List (2nd level)
<https://www.icann.org/resources/pages/reserved-2013-07-08-en>
- ⦿ This list will also serve as reference for future application rounds (Top-level)

Implementation steps

- ⦿ The 22 March 2013 GAC List contains Full Names of the IGO in English only
- ⦿ ICANN Staff is working to gather "up to two languages"
- ⦿ The 2nd language is to be optional
- ⦿ Letter drafted to send to GAC
- ⦿ Next steps: Akram's signature, submit to GAC, follow up with ICANN GAC support team
