

Meeting Notes

Mark summarized the previous meeting and explained the agenda. The focus of the meeting is item number 2. The next part of the action item would be to figure out how to hire a vendor based on the Score Generator template, and part two would be helping the early EAI adopters to test out the Score Generator.

Mark shared his spreadsheet and explained the workflow of EAI Self-Certification Score Generator. He explained how the scores would be generated by the Score Generator using the spreadsheet. The scores are based on how many tests were passed, as silver, gold or platinum. The silver tests are the most basic parts of overall Universal Acceptance and the whole test will be failed if one silver criteria is failed.

Mark referred to the architectural diagram presented in the previous meeting.



Arnt said it looked good to move on to the next step with what we already have.



Mark asked if it is possible for ICANN Staff or Community member to complete the spreadsheet before explaining to the vendor using this. Also, to finish or clean up the guide and let the vendor use it. This will be discussed more.

Arnt questioned and discussed about item 2.c. user acceptance test whether this item refers to the companies or end-users. Mark answered the definition could be pretty vague. Abdalmonem explained about this item. We shall figure out the UAT topic after checking with comms and early adopters.

Action item for the next meeting is to define who are the early EAI adapters and to plan the testing stages for item 2.c User Acceptance tests.
