Mark Sv. (Chair) provided an update that he has received back from the Microsoft browser team who were supportive, the login and UA/EAI validation on the browser or other tools is done by Microsoft's Accounts team. He reached to the Microsoft's Account team, this UA/EAI support has been in the backlog for several years, because they were waiting for more EAI adoption.

Unfortunately, Microsoft team won't proceed and make the changes unless it will benefit another internal team. The WG members appreciated Mark follow up on the issue, he



indicated that we should proceed and issue the WHATWG letter, someone else from Microsoft can sign it beside him and we should also get our other stakeholders to sign it as well.

Although Microsoft is not using the HTML5 email validation but a separate code, this is good news if we are planning to reach the tech companies for resolving similar issues.
