### Meeting notes:

Abdelmonem updated the group about his EAI tests done Apple iOS 14.1 which Apple indicated that it supports sending and receiving email messages from non-Latin scripts email accounts. He presented screenshots of the outcomes of the testing process, unfortunately, he was not able to set up an Arabic script email address, it failed the SSL certificate validation.

Mohamed provided an update about ICANN69 UA sessions which are confirmed and published in the meetings schedule:

- Outreach for addressing Universal Acceptance on Monday, October 19, 2020
- Remediating Universal Acceptance issues on Tuesday, October 20, 2020
- Community updates on Universal Acceptance Readiness on Wednesday, October 21, 2020

Harish and Sushanta informed the WG that one of the Indian Government major departments, the vehicles and driver licenses agency has started using a Devanagari script domain name and uses EAI to communicate with the general public.

The group discussed the 3 options and approaches for remediating and agreed to continue the discussion in the next WG meetings, as the topic requires detailed discussion.
