Mohamed presented an update about the result of reaching out to Mozilla, Mozilla team indicated that they support WHATWG request to update the "email" validation to include EAI. Mozilla Thunderbird team said that they start working on EAI support in 2021 to be released in 2022.

The WG continued drafting the EAI compliance self-certification document. The group discussion focused on identifying and agreeing on the levels of EAI support, the terms of EAI support (Phase 1 and phase 2) might not be suitable to be used for email utilities and tools.
