Meeting Notes

In this meeting, it was decided to take two things from FY22 Action Plan first:

- The first is online web hosting tools to check their UA readiness.
- Second thing is to continue working on Content Management Systems (CMS). This is the last year work and we can expand that.

There are two kinds of tools: open source, and paid services.

Idea is to look at both based on their popularity.

There is an advantage in this work as we built a know-how on testing these systems.

Web hosting tools like cPanel do not support UA properly. To develop SOW for such software, we need to look at the **services** what cPanel should provide to be UA compliant. In SOW, we need to specify what should be done for testing of such software.

It was decided to start with the web hosting tools first as part of "M2" item in the FY22 Action Plan. We might need to look at software popularity **geographically.** List of URLs were shared in this regard and then it was decided to **shortlist** them. And then the group will come up with a **testing plan** for cPanel and similar platforms. Following are the links of the websites from which shortlisting can be done:
