x) The ALAC is also responsible, working in conjunction with the RALOs, for coordinating the following activities:

(A) Nominating individuals to fill Seat 15 on the Board. Notification of the At-Large Community's nomination shall be given by the ALAC Chair in writing to the EC Administration, with a copy to the Secretary, and the EC shall promptly act on it as provided in Section 7.25. **BCEC & BMSPC Appointments**

(B) Keeping the community of individual Internet users informed about the significant news from ICANN; SO-AC **newsletters, blogs, brochures**

(C) Distributing (through posting or otherwise) an updated agenda, news about ICANN, and information about items in the ICANN policy-development process; **SO-AC reports from David Olive**

(D) Promoting outreach activities in the community of individual Internet users; **RALOs – newsletters, online reports – all?**

(E) Developing and maintaining on-going information and education programs, regarding ICANN and its work; **ICANN Learn, RALO developed?**

(F) Establishing an outreach strategy about ICANN issues in each RALO's Geographic Region; **RALO O&E strategies online**

(G) Participating in the ICANN policy development processes and providing input and advice that accurately reflects the views of individual Internet users; **CPWG, RALO perspectives to CPWG discussions ??**

(H) Making public, and analyzing, ICANN's proposed policies and its decisions and their (potential) regional impact and (potential) effect on individuals in the region; **RALOs report on monthly meeting, further discussion & analysis??**

(I) Offering Internet-based mechanisms that enable discussions among members of At-Large Structures; **RALOs ???**

(xi) Establishing mechanisms and processes that enable two-way communication between members of At-Large Structures and those involved in ICANN decision-making, so interested individuals can share their views on pending ICANN issues.

Forward planning - EOIs

- Succession planning for the Liaison positions – must have interest and some experience of the constituency concerns
- BMSPC and BCEC positions – RALOs choosing best candidates
- FBSC – call for new membership – one ALAC and one RALO member, others welcome – must be interested in Financial matters and contributing to ALAC comments about ICANN Budgetary issues
- IFRT – call for an At-Large rep on this committee (IANA Function Review Team) – have had one person interested – skills needed
- ALAC Appointments Sub-Committee – one ALAC and one RALO member for these kinds of in-house appointments
