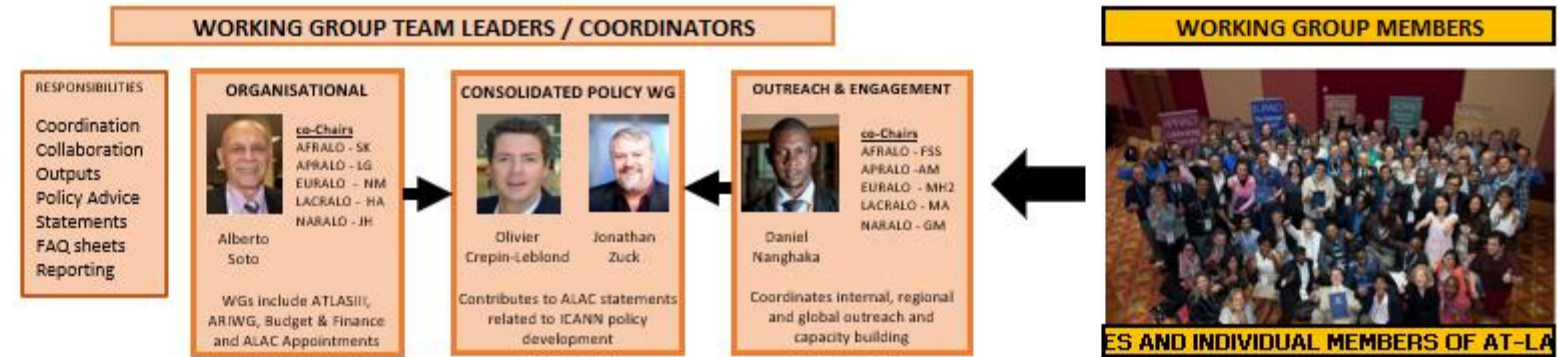
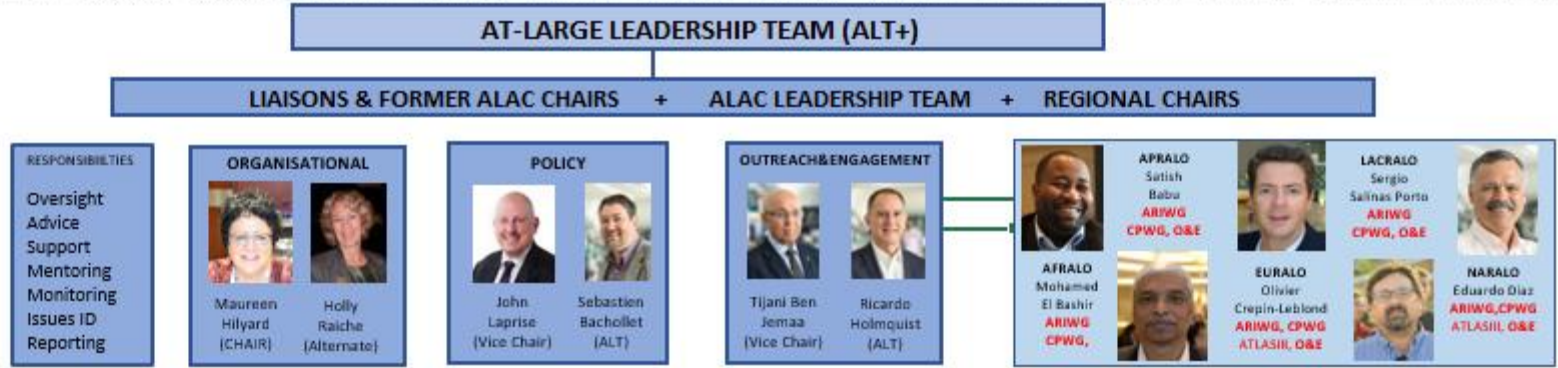

## AT-LARGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (ALAC) ORGANISATIONAL CHART

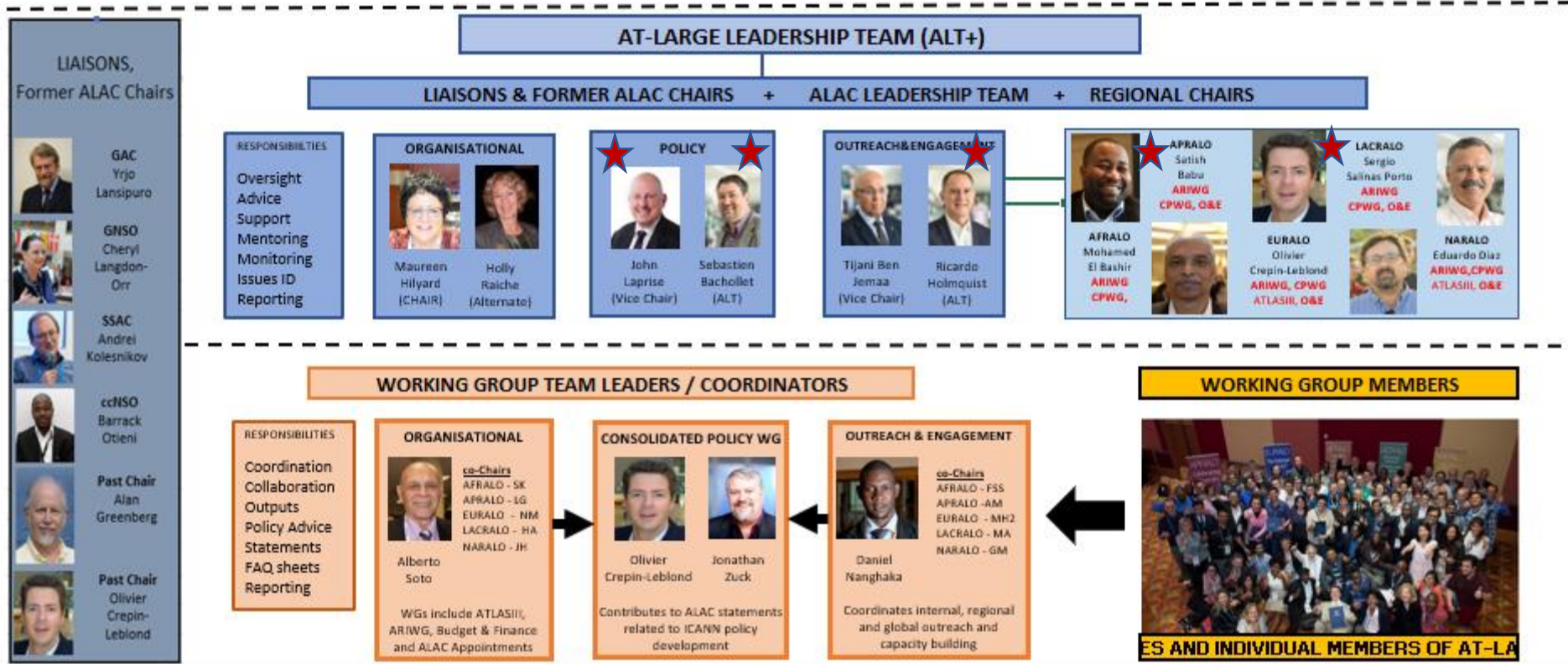

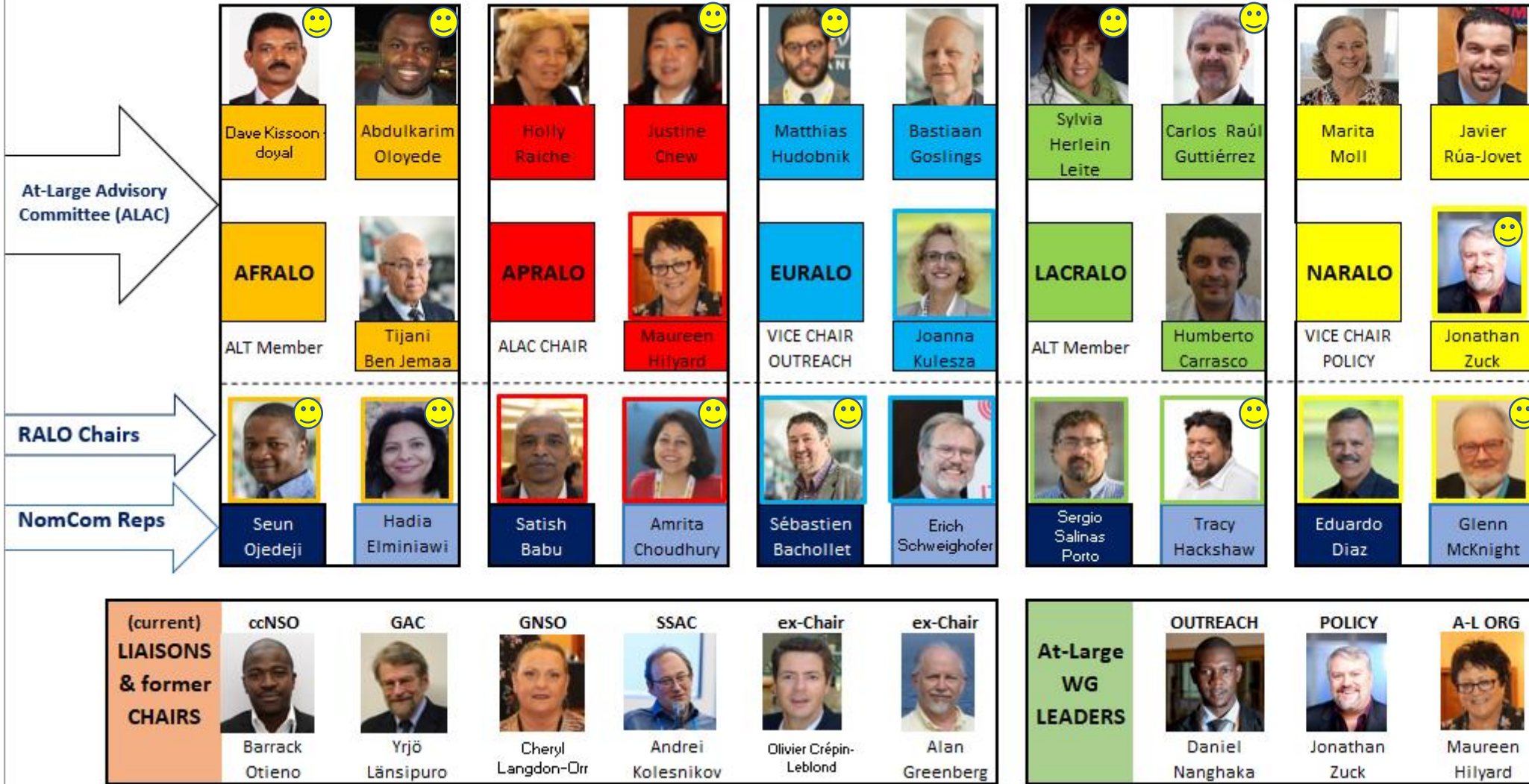
# Achievements during 2019

- ALT+ was established - an ALAC-RALO sounding board on various issues
- Weekly CPWG meetings grew in membership and in policy workload – FBSC will address any ICANN Finance topics
- More Policy sessions at ICANN meetings – with talking points – more shared moderation of session
- Outreach & Engagement includes Capacity Building sessions and workshops at ICANN meetings – focus on communication issues – co-Chairs involved in organisation of regional events
- Working in collaboration with GAC, NCUC, NPOC – coordinated approach to resource development – between and at ICANN meetings
- Strategic plans developed by all RALOS – in collaboration with GSE and other external partners
- Near completion of many of our At-Large Review items – still some work to be done – post-ATLAS activities will focus on remaining item – Issue 2 – ALS criteria and engagement
- BCEC and BMSPC established for the selection of the At-Large Board member
- Several representatives selected to represent At-Large on several specialist working groups : CSC, IRFC, ATRT3, Fellowship Mentor and Selection Committee member, NomCom Representatives.
- Community volunteers established the criteria and a selection process for ATLAS
- ATLAS programme is ready to go.

# ICANN Bylaws : Article 12.2 (d) (x)

## **x) The ALAC is also responsible, working in conjunction with the RALOs, for coordinating the following activities:**

(A) Nominating individuals to fill Seat 15 on the Board. Notification of the At-Large Community's nomination shall be given by the ALAC Chair in writing to the EC Administration, with a copy to the Secretary, and the EC shall promptly act on it as provided in Section 7.25. **BCEC & BMSPC Appointments**

(B) Keeping the community of individual Internet users informed about the significant news from ICANN; SO-AC **newsletters, blogs, brochures**

(C) Distributing (through posting or otherwise) an updated agenda, news about ICANN, and information about items in the ICANN policy-development process; **SO-AC reports from David Olive**

(D) Promoting outreach activities in the community of individual Internet users; **RALOs – newsletters, online reports – all?**

(E) Developing and maintaining on-going information and education programs, regarding ICANN and its work; **ICANN Learn, RALO developed?**

(F) Establishing an outreach strategy about ICANN issues in each RALO's Geographic Region; **RALO O&E strategies online**

(G) Participating in the ICANN policy development processes and providing input and advice that accurately reflects the views of individual Internet users; **CPWG, RALO WG perspectives to CPWG discussions ??**

(H) Making public, and analyzing, ICANN's proposed policies and its decisions and their (potential) regional impact and (potential) effect on individuals in the region; **RALOs report on monthly meeting, further discussion & analysis??**

(I) Offering Internet-based mechanisms that enable discussions among members of At-Large Structures; **RALOs ???**

**(xi) Establishing mechanisms and processes that enable two-way communication between members of At-Large Structures and those involved in ICANN decision-making, so interested individuals can share their views on pending ICANN issues.**

- Continue to grow and strengthen the capacity of the CPWG by focusing policy development within At-Large on a policy platform that will concentrate on end-user needs
