





## ICANN Bylaws: Article 12.2 (d) (x)

### x) The ALAC is also responsible, working in conjunction with the RALOs, for coordinating the following activities:

- (A) Nominating individuals to fill Seat 15 on the Board. Notification of the At-Large Community's nomination shall be given by the ALAC Chair in writing to the EC Administration, with a copy to the Secretary, and the EC shall promptly act on it as provided in Section 7.25. BCEC & BMSPC Appointments
- (B) Keeping the community of individual Internet users informed about the significant news from ICANN; SO-AC newsletters, blogs, brochures
- (C) Distributing (through posting or otherwise) an updated agenda, news about ICANN, and information about items in the ICANN policy-development process; SO-AC reports from David Olive
- (D) Promoting outreach activities in the community of individual Internet users; RALOs newsletters, online reports all?
- (E) Developing and maintaining on-going information and education programs, regarding ICANN and its work; ICANN Learn, RALO developed?
- (F) Establishing an outreach strategy about ICANN issues in each RALO's Geographic Region; RALO O&E strategies onlne
- (G) Participating in the ICANN policy development processes and providing input and advice that accurately reflects the views of individual Internet users; CPWG, RALO WG perspectives to CPWG diiscussions??
- (H) Making public, <u>and analyzing</u>, ICANN's proposed policies and its decisions and their (potential) regional impact and (potential) effect on individuals in the region; RALOs report on monthly meeting, further discussion & analysis??
- (I) Offering Internet-based mechanisms that enable discussions among members of At-Large Structures; RALOs ???
- (xi) Establishing mechanisms and processes that enable two-way communication between members of At-Large Structures and those involved in ICANN decision-making, so interested individuals can share their views on pending ICANN issues.

### 2020 vision

- Focus on strengthening ALAC and RALO leadership teams and individual RALO participants to become future thought leaders, change agents and At-Large leaders
- Continue to grow and strengthen the capacity of the CPWG by focusing policy development within At-Large on a policy platform that will concentrate on end-user needs
- Work together to build policy & outreach capacity at regional level based on ATLAS & At-Large Review and help to reduce potential volunteer burnout
- Use expertise on CPWG and O&E WG to develop resources to support RALO capacity building and member participation in At-Large activities
- Continue to collaborate with internal partners (GAC, ccNSO, NCUC & NPOC) as well as external partners within our respective regions to help At-Large carry out its mandated obligations to ICANN
