



- Accreditation Body Baseline Policy
  - Defines the minimum baseline policy requirements all Accreditation Bodies must adhere to.
  - Set by ICANN Policy.
- Accreditation Body Practice Statement
  - Describes how an Accreditation Body meets the baseline requirements and defines additional requirements beyond the baseline (specific to their area of focus – IP, LEA, Cybersecurity, etc.)
  - Developed by an Accreditation Body
- Accreditation Body Auditor
  - Ensures Accreditation Body Practice Statement and meets all requirements of the Baseline Requirements
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> party (perhaps approved list of 3<sup>rd</sup> party)
- Accreditation Body
  - Implementation of Requirements. Receives requests, processes/approves requests, validates identify of enrollee, issues credentials.
  - Implemented and Operated by Accreditation Body
- Trusted Accreditation Body Program Policy
  - Describes policy and process to become an approved accreditation body.
  - Set by ICANN Policy
- Accreditation Body Approval and Onboarding
  - Checks that policy has been followed. (Approval, Revocation, etc.)
  - Maintains an Accreditation Trust List, used by SSAD.
  - Run by ICANN (or 3<sup>rd</sup> party on behalf of ICANN)
- Requestors
  - Individual requesting a credential from the Accreditor
  - Credential is issued if the requestor meet the criteria of the Accreditor.
- SSAD
  - Uses Accreditation Trust List to validate credentials.
  - Processes RDAP requests per policy.
