



About Transbot



About Transbot

Enables LACRALO English and Spanish members to collaborate in their native language over email. Transbot monitors LAC-Discuss-EN/S lists for incoming email. New messages are machine-translated and routed to both lists leveraging Google Translate.

Facilitates near real-time machine translation between distinct unilingual mailing lists



Sample Email Translation (English – Spanish)



How we got here

Transbot was originally built upon legacy code that was not aligned with the ICANN platform strategy and not to coding best practices. This culminated in a reactive environment for maintaining. In August 2019, E&IT secured budget to engage a 3rd party development resource to provide a complete rewrite of code to best practices.



What's in this release



What's in this release


- Critical under-the-hood improvements:
 - Complete rewrite in Java leveraging ICANN's Continuous Integration (CI) / Continuous Delivery (CD) framework.
 - Increased logging for more visibility into possible failure points.
- Built for scale to support future expansion for additional mailing lists and languages.
- Minor Features & Fixes
 - <dnt> tag no longer case sensitive.
 - Addressed some formatting issues (e.g. organisation translated as organización).
 - Messages that fail translation will go to the other list untranslated.
