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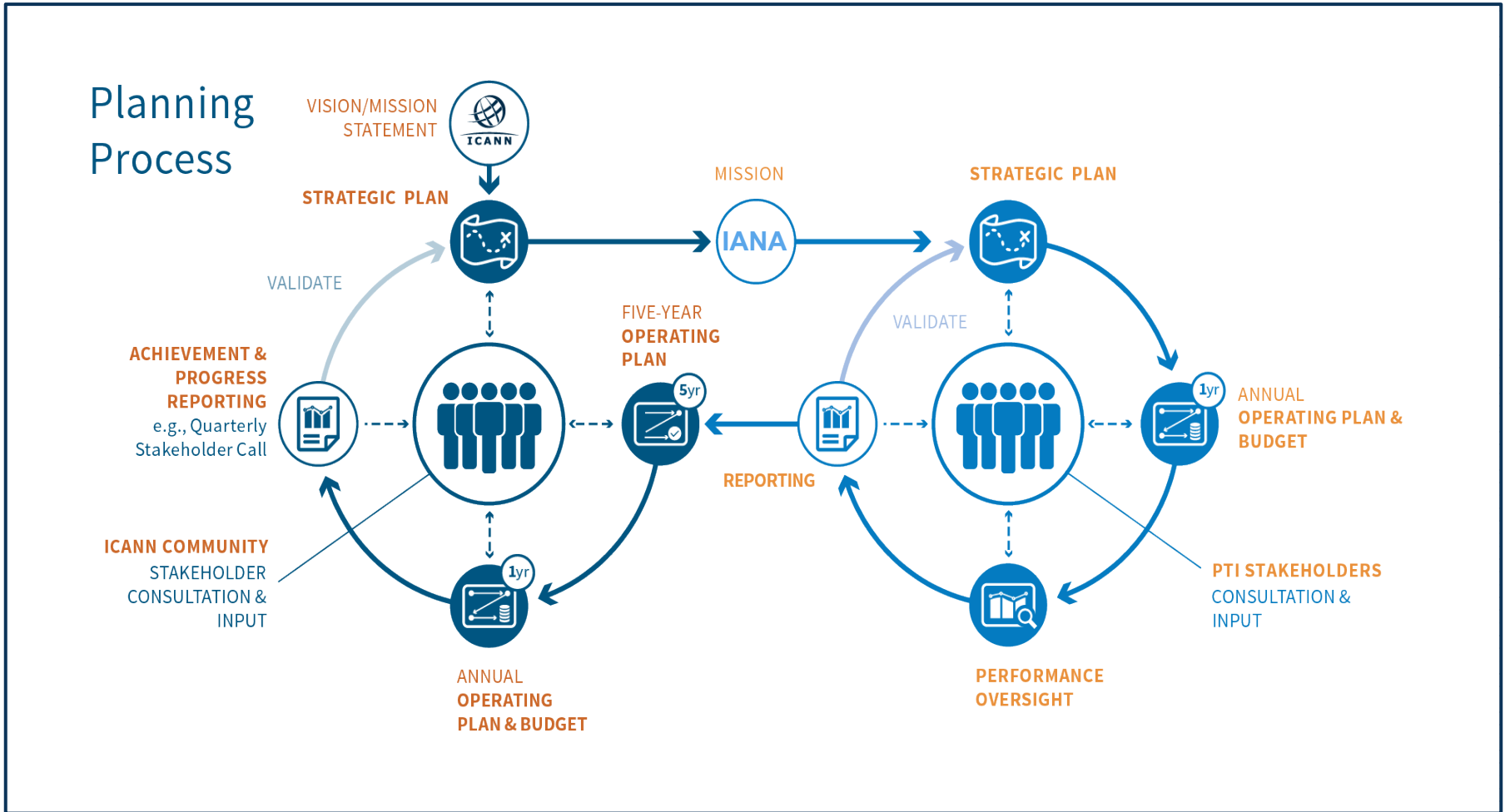

Process Overview: Planning Process Steps

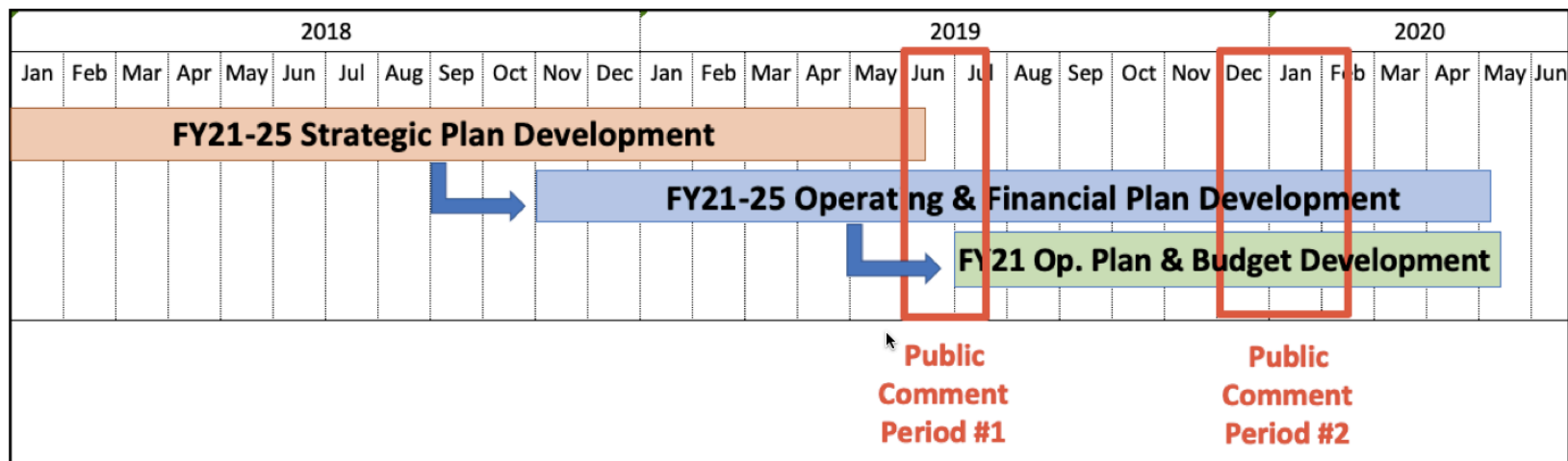


Planning Process

FY21- FY25 Strategic Plan (SP) outlines ICANN’s Vision and Mission, sets out five strategic objectives and related goals based on areas of challenge and opportunity for ICANN to shape its future successfully.

FY21-FY25 Operating & Financial Plan (O&FP) includes 1) Financial assumptions and high-level projection of the “base-case”, “high” and “low” funding scenarios for FY21-FY25, and 2) ICANN org will undertake existing and new activities to achieve the strategic outcome set out in the FY21-FY25 Strategic Plan.

FY21 Operating Plan & Budget (OP&B) sets forth the focus of efforts and organizational commitments for the current fiscal year.

Next Step

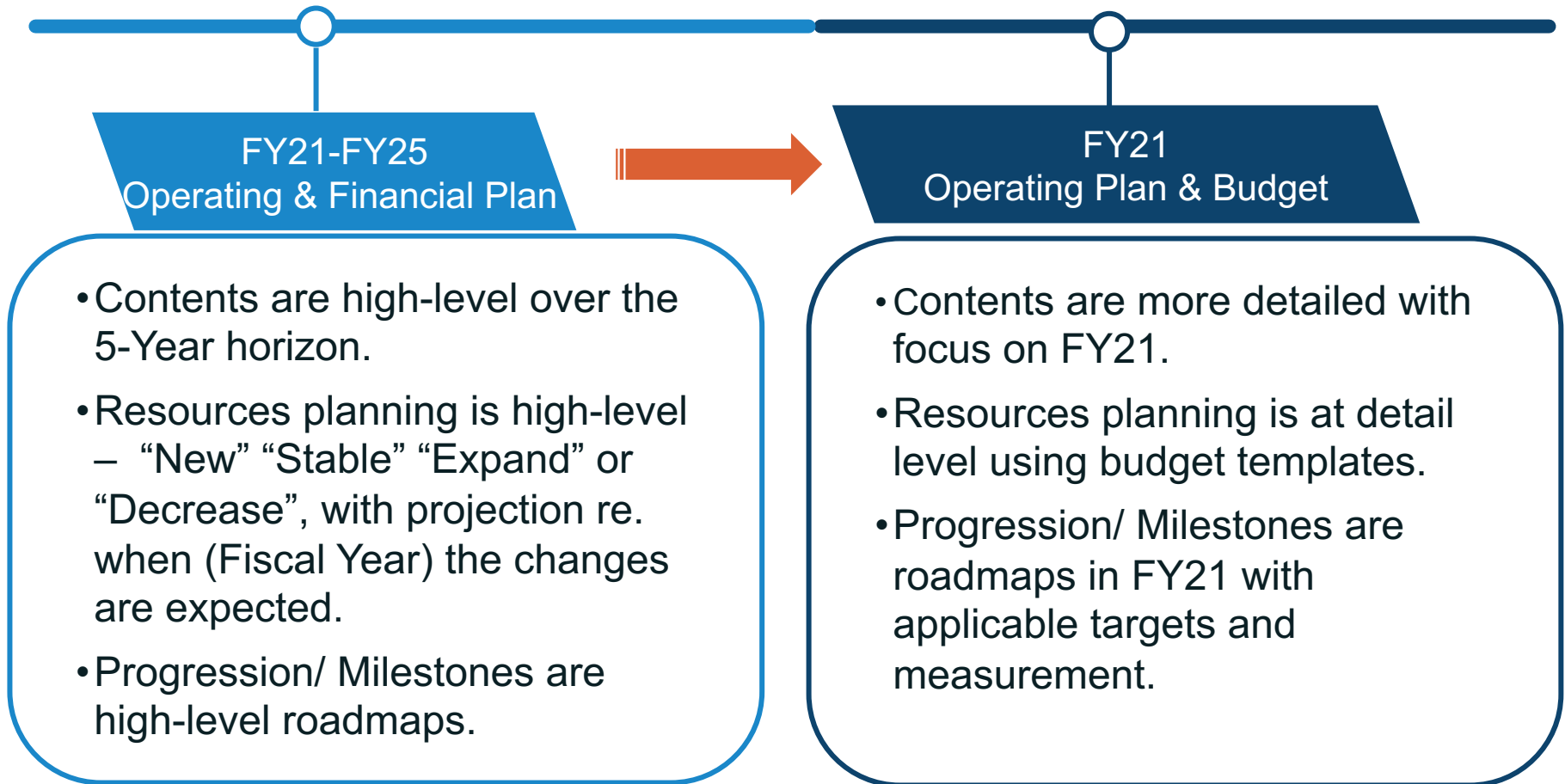
- ⦿ ICANN org will incorporate feedback from this Public Comment #1 proceeding to continue the development of the FY21-25 O&FP.
- ⦿ Draft FY21-25 O&FP will be discussed with ICANN Board, then published for Public Comment #2 in December 2019, with the comment period running until February 2020.
- ⦿ Comments received during Public Comment #2 will be available for consideration by the Board and ICANN community at ICANN67 in March 2020.
- ⦿ After ICANN67, the proposed final FY21-25 O&FP is intended to be presented to the ICANN Board with the aim of Board adoption in May / June 2020.

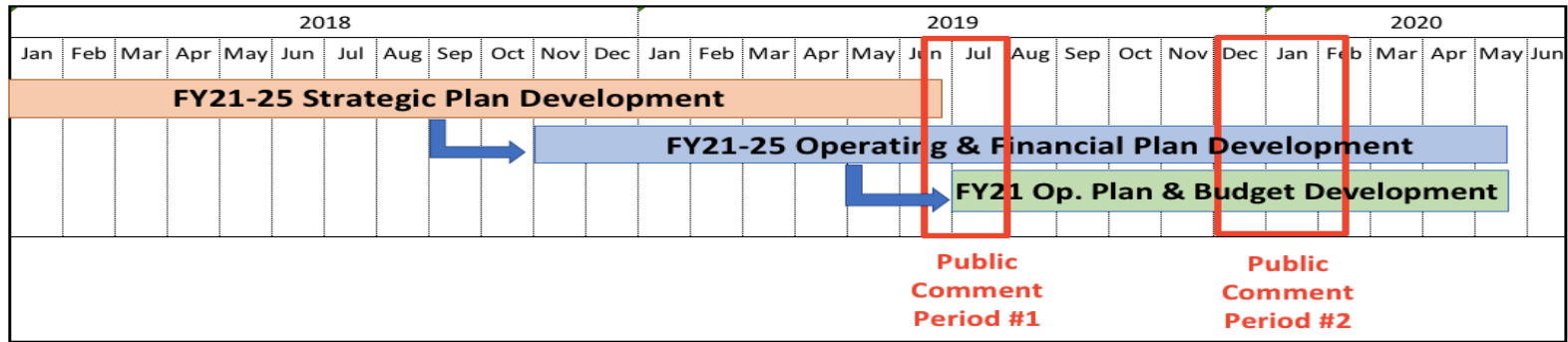

FY21 Operating Plan and Budget Key Process Updates

- ⦿ Annual Timeline
 - The timing of the Public Comment period for the Draft FY21 Operating Plan and Budget publication has been coordinated with the FY21-FY25 Five Year Operating Plan public comment period.
 - The adoption of the FY21 Operating Plan and Budget is similar to FY20 Process
 - Permits Board approval well in advance of the next fiscal year
 - Provides time for the Empowered community process (28 days) before the start of the next fiscal year
- ⦿ Timing of Approval for SO/AC Additional Budget Requests
 - Current process results in approval at the same time as overall Board approval

Key Changes- Improved Structure and Transparency

- We have improved our reporting and project structure to increase transparency and visibility regarding key information and initiatives
 - Last year we posted 5 documents for the annual budget and 5 year plan update, this year we will post 4 documents
 - In the past, we provided transparency into all activities and projects
 - This year, we have narrowed our focus to reduce complexity and improve the transparency regarding key initiatives and projects

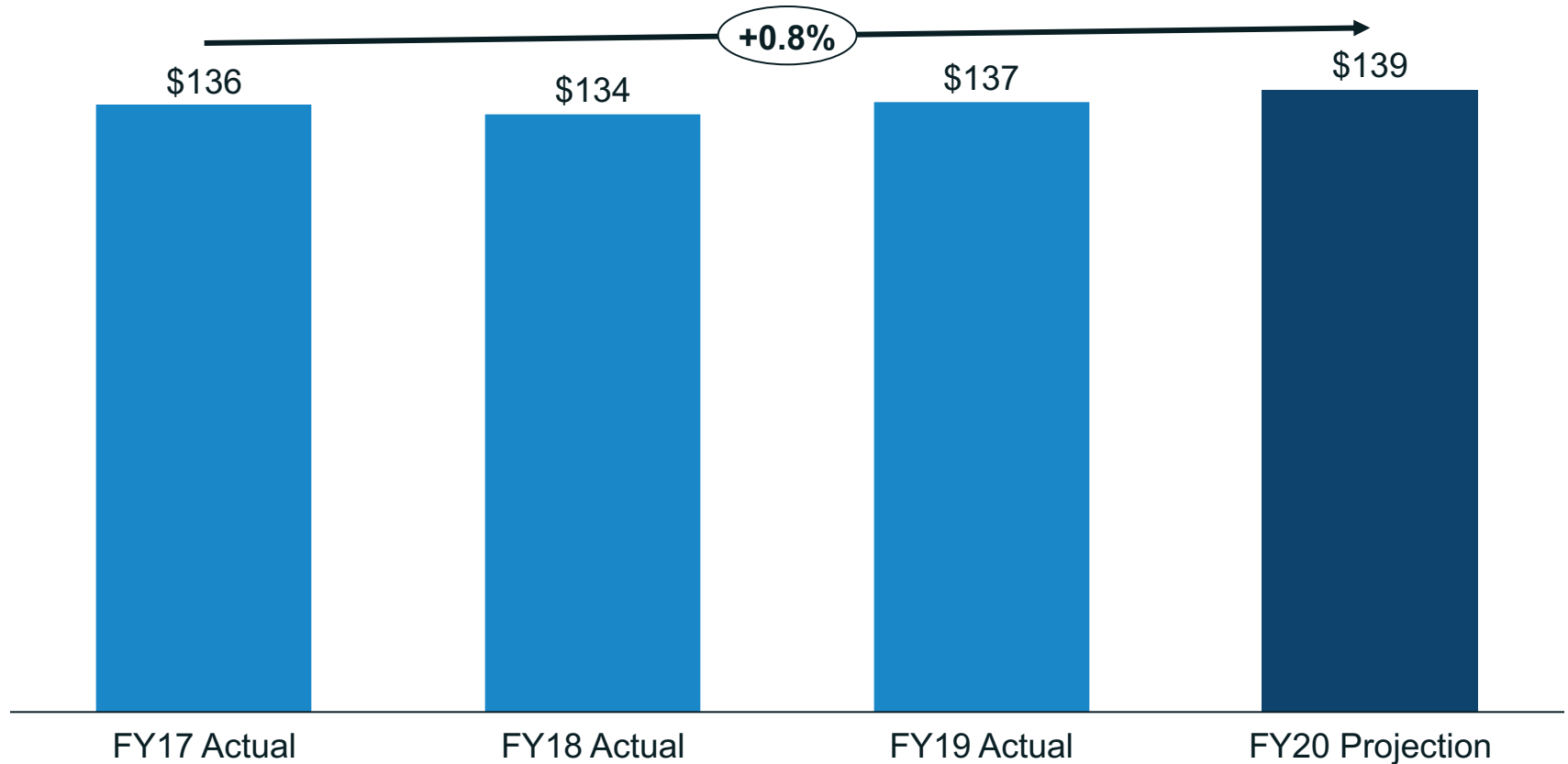

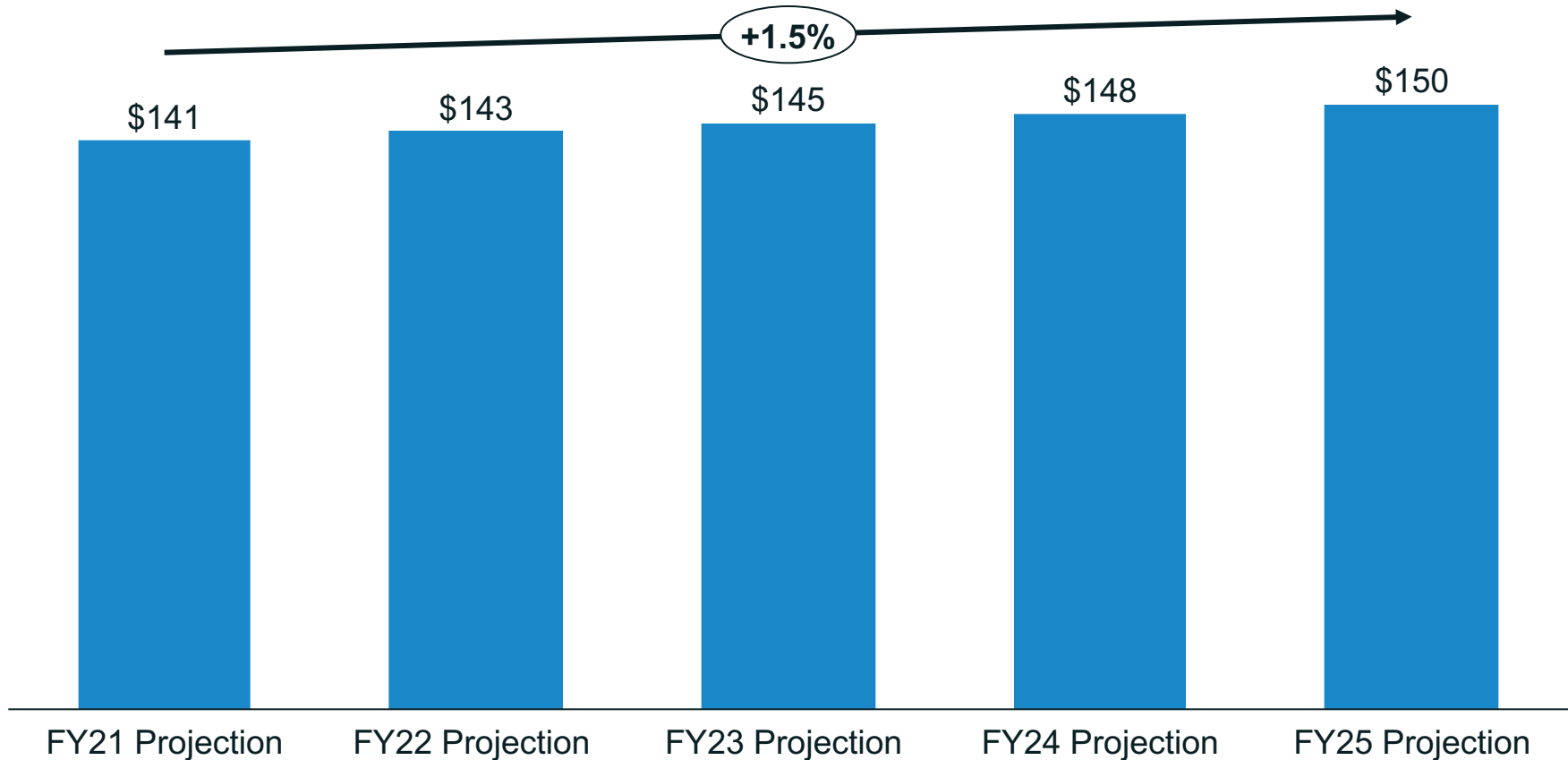
Recent Funding Trends

- Funding has stabilized and is growing at a very modest rate, this directly impacts our Budget



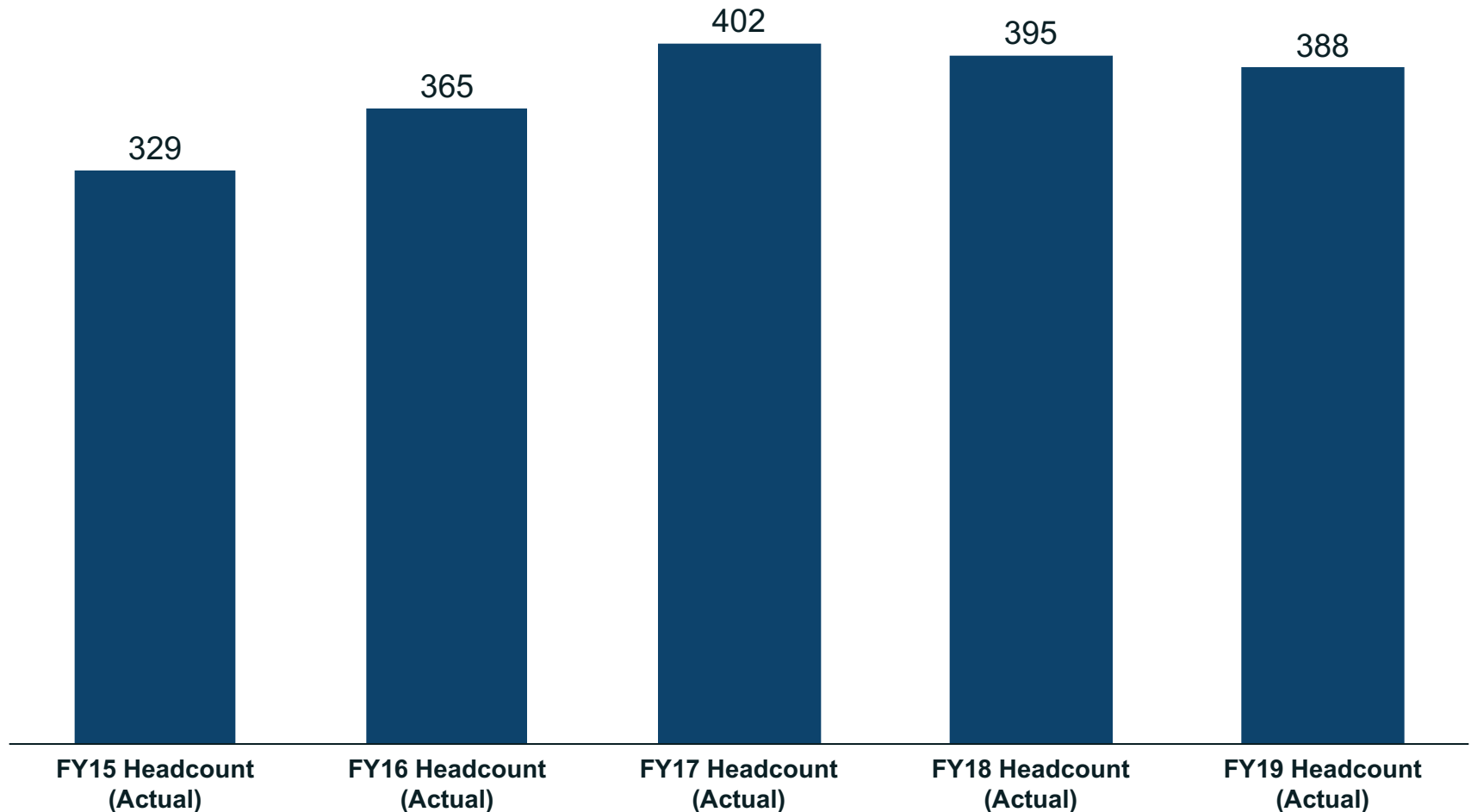
5 Year Funding Projections

- Our Base Case 5-Year Funding projections suggest that Funding growth will be less than inflation



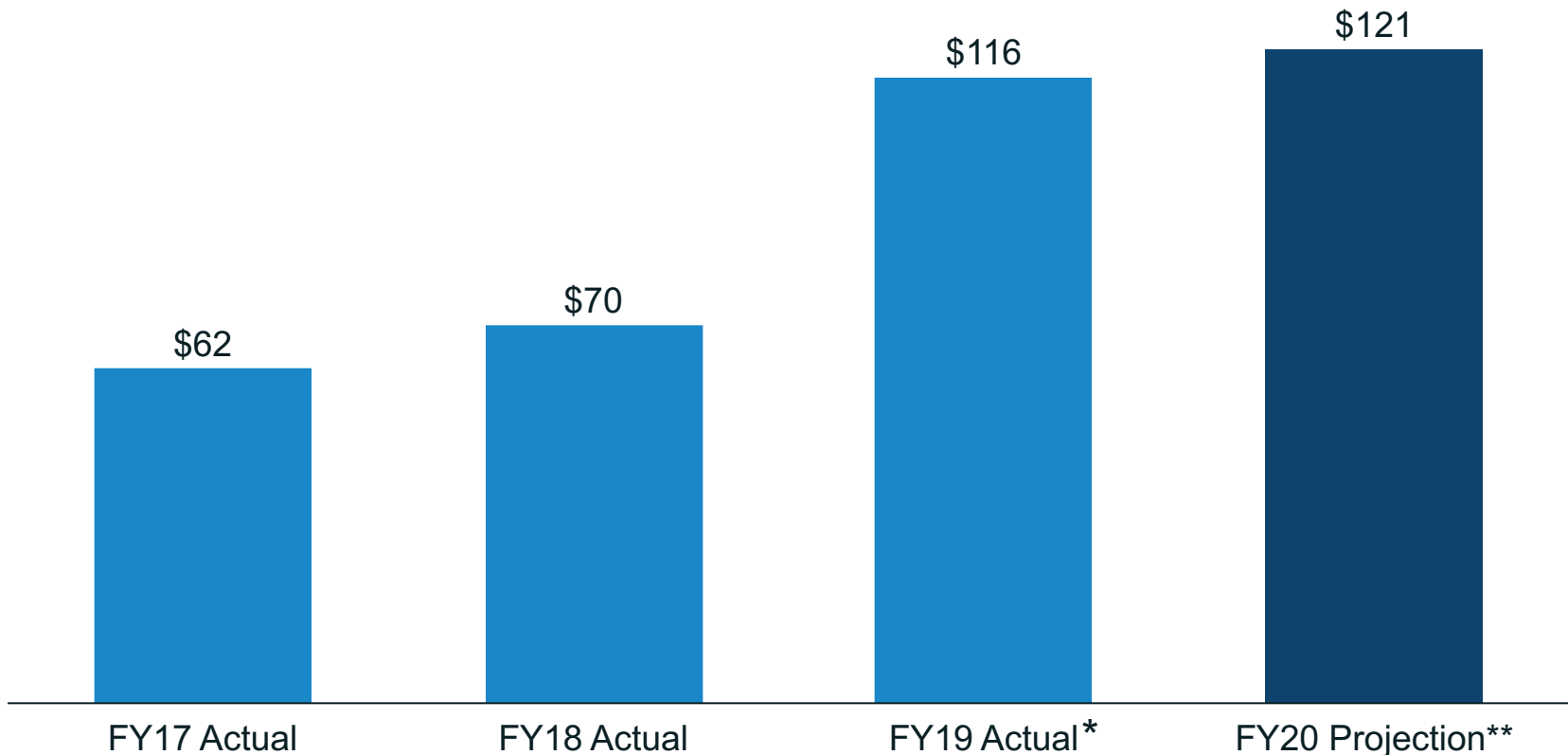
Headcount Trending (End of Period)

- ICANN headcount has begun to stabilize in alignment with our Funding growth



Reserve Fund Replenishment Strategy

- In alignment with the Board Approved Reserve Fund Replenishment Strategy, the FY21 Budget will include a planned contribution



FY21 Planning Expense Assumptions

- ICANN organization's activities and projects result directly or indirectly from Bylaws requirements, and from decisions made by the Board based on community-led policies or recommendations
 - At this time, we are not including implementation work from future Board decisions that have yet to be approved
 - The Budget will include contingency funding for unplanned work that has yet to be approved
- The FY21 draft budget will include a planned contribution to the Reserve Fund
- Headcount is expected to remain relatively stable
- The FY21 draft budget will be a balanced budget where expenses plus a planned contribution to the reserve fund will not exceed funding

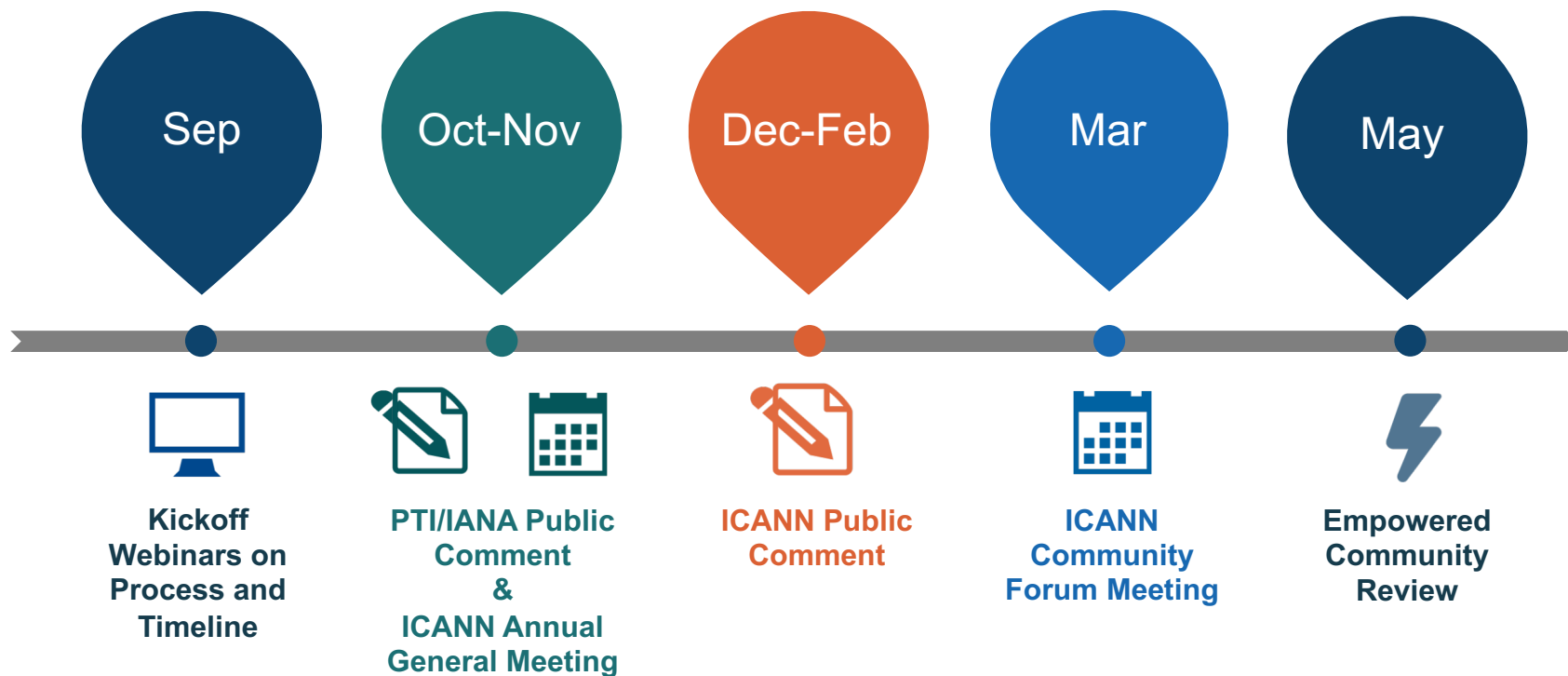
