MINUTES

Call to Order

Brad Verd called the teleconference to order at 22:03 UTC and reviewed the proposed agenda. There were no objections to the agenda.

April 2023 Workshop

Brad Verd reviewed the matrix that tracks the evolution of draft principles for root server system governance. The matrix will be the basis of discussions during the April 2023 workshop. The matrix builds on the work sessions from ICANN76 in Cancun, Mexico. The matrix also includes considerations for implementation that provide guidance on the draft principles.

Brad Verd reviewed the schedule for the April 2023 workshop. The schedule consists of ten 90-minute sessions over 2.5 days. Brad Verd encouraged the GWG to prepare for the workshop by reviewing the matrix.

Brad Verd asked the GWG for feedback on the proposed schedule for the April 2023 workshop. Wes Hardaker asked what steps the GWG can take to get to the finish line. Brad Verd stated that alignment on the draft principles was important before developing governance processes and a governance structure. Suzanne Woolf also asked about how the GWG will put the principles together. Brad Verd noted that the schedule includes a session to discuss next steps.

Finally, Brad Verd highlighted the time on the April 2023 workshop schedule to discuss potential candidate principles that have emerged from previous work sessions.
