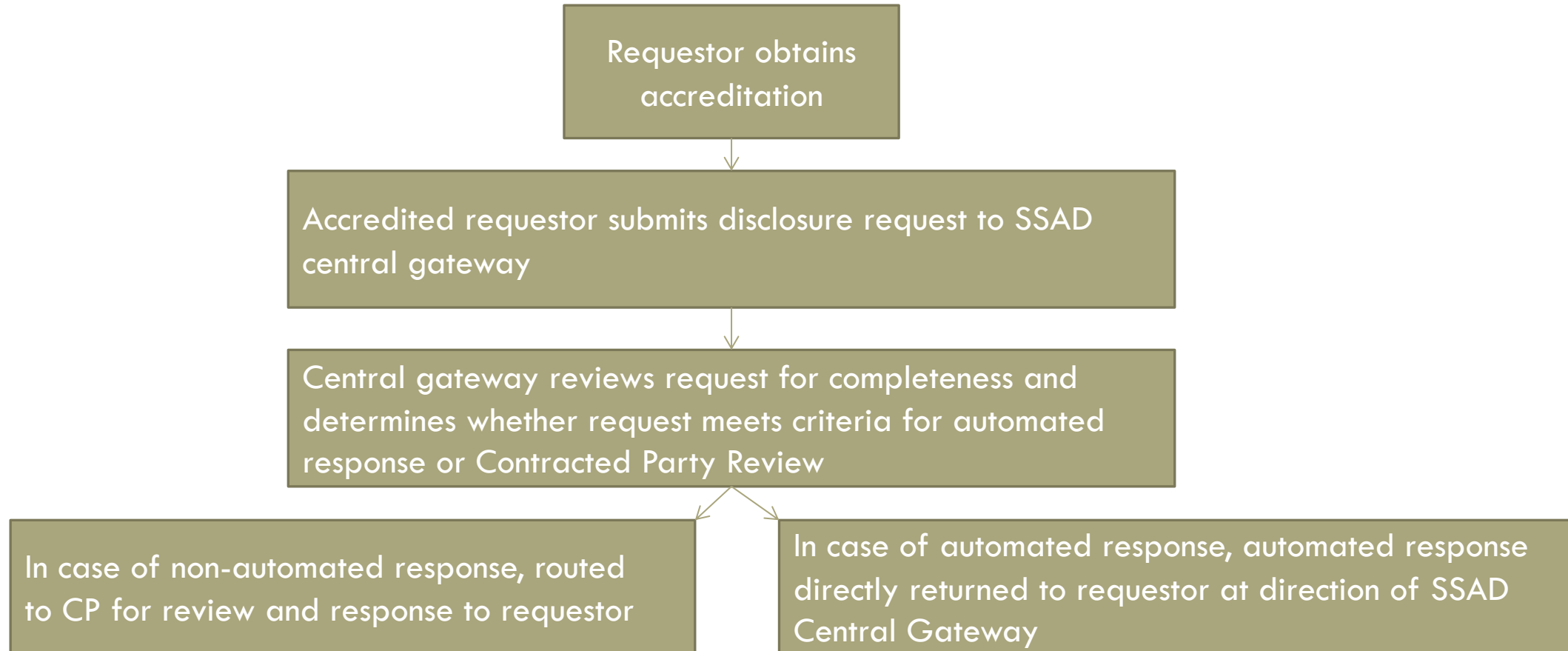

THE CHAMELEON SSAD MODEL

- ❑ Proposal for an SSAD Hybrid model able to evolve to a centralized and automated Model
- ❑ If deemed technically possible and legally permissible, the requests that are assessed to be eligible for an automated response are expected to grow over time
- ❑ It is not expected that all requests ultimately will end up in the automated category
- ❑ It is the expectation that there are always edge cases that will require manual review

PRINCIPLES THAT UNDERPIN THE HYBRID SSAD MODEL

- ❑ No legal opinion, guidance, or advice has been received, waiting for this to happen could significantly delay the implementation of an SSAD
- ❑ It may be difficult to determine or commit to response time requirements, as a result of experience gained efficiencies are expected to develop.
- ❑ SSAD must be automated where technically feasible and legally permissible, where automation is not both technically feasible and legally permissible, standardization is the baseline objective.
- ❑ A standing committee of sorts would need to be put in place to oversee and guide the continuous improvements of the SSAD
