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DNS Abuse Definition

- No Accepted Definition
- Basically
 - Abuse = attacks on the DNS (ex DOS)
 - Misuse = using the DNS for attacks (ie Phishing)
- Often strays into content
- Accepted
 - Abuse
 - Malware, Phishing

CCT

- Findings
 - Safeguards did not work in 2012
 - DNS Abuse just shifted to new gTLDs
 - Central problem was the lack of a wholistic approach
- Recommendations
 - Create incentives for best practices
 - Set thresholds
 - Give new tools to Compliance

At-Large Recommendations

- Implement CCT Recommendations
- Drastically reduce bulk sales
 - Perhaps price minimum
 - Perhaps some accreditation process?

Contracted Party Concerns

- DNS Abuse Definitions can become too broad
- It's a moving target
- More “regulation” not helpful

At-Large Position

- Critical issue to Individual End Users
- More can be done in terms of best practices
- We NEED to get to BAD actors
- Compliance is the way there
