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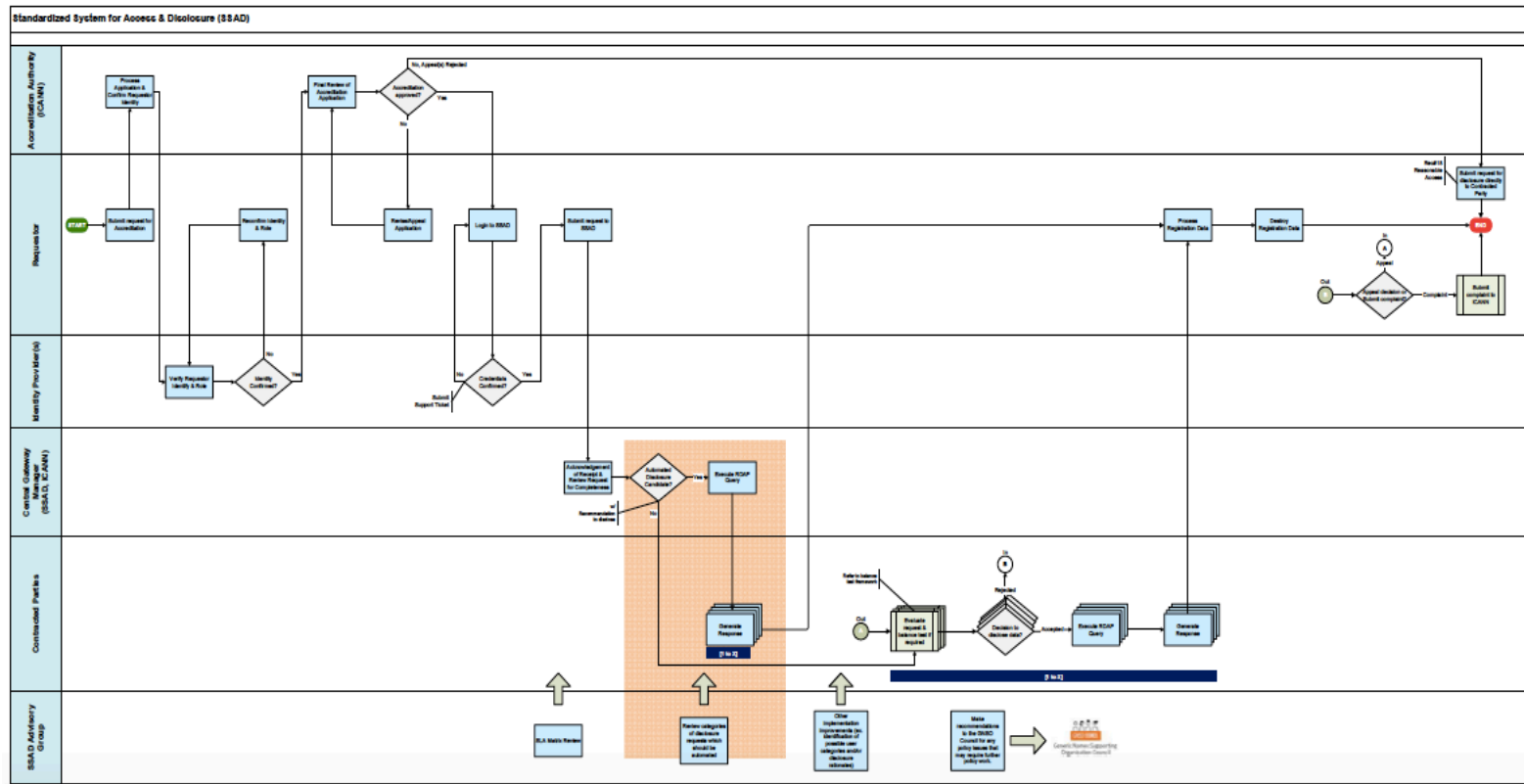

DRAFT INITIAL REPORT

- ❑ The report includes 19 recommendations
- ❑ The report does not address priority 2 issues
- ❑ Published for public comments 7 February

PROPOSED SSAD MODEL



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- ❑ Full automation of the SSAD may not be possible, but the EPDP Team recommends that the SSAD must be automated where technically feasible AND legally permissible. Additionally, in areas where automation is not both technically feasible and legally permissible, harmonization is the baseline objective.
- ❑ Experience gained over time with SSAD disclosure requests and responses must inform further streamlining and standardization of responses.
- ❑ A feedback mechanism, which focuses solely on the implementation of the SSAD will need to be put in place.

BENEFITS OF THE MODEL

- Single location to submit requests
- Standardized request forms
- Built in authentication process
- Standardized review and response process

ACCREDITATION & DISCLOSURE

- ❑ SSAD must only accept requests for access/disclosure from accredited organizations or individuals, including organizations or individuals who make a single request
- ❑ Single accreditation authority run and managed by ICANN org
- ❑ Decision to authorize disclosure will rest with either the registry, registrar or ICANN as applicable
- ❑ Some predetermined request cases would be eligible for automated disclosure without human intervention
- ❑ An accreditation body auditor will be identified
