#### **DNS Abuse**

- Current levels of DNS Abuse are unacceptable and rising.
- Compliance needs new tools to combat systemic DNS Abuse.
- No new round of applications until DNS Abuse is addressed.

## **Registrant Data**

- Want to protect the privacy of registrants.
- Need to balance with consumer protection.
- Current EPDP outcome insufficient to protect individual end users.
- Relevant Sessions at ICANN68

## **Subsequent Procedures**

- The work of the SubPro WG is incomplete.
- DNS concerns must be addressed prior to ANY new round.
- Remain concerned about indigenous and community participation.

# Registry Voluntary Commitments (previously PICs)

- Must have a way to hold registries to their commitments
- History of PICs is difficulty with enforcement
- Contract Compliance must identify RVCs which will be difficult to enforce
- At-Large Requires Means/Money to bring a DRP on behalf of End Users

## **Universal Acceptance (UA)**

- 80% of websites non-compliant.
- Undermines ICANN's credibility.
- Must be addressed prior to ANY new round.
