Proposed Mechanism

GNSO Guidance Process (GGP)

 From the GGP Manual: A GGP may be initiated by the GNSO Council when a request for input relating to gTLDs (either a new issue or in relation to previous policy recommendations) has been received from the ICANN Board or a gTLD issue has been identified by the GNSO Council that would benefit from GNSO Guidance

GGP

- Must be initiated by the GNSO
- Specific task oriented
 - Work
 - Final Report
 - Approval
 - Terminate

Problems

- No way to compel GGP to occur (although it is unlikely the GNSO would decide not to convene the GGP)
- GNSO would have to agree to make the GGP ongoing with multiple "Final Reports" in contravention of the GGP Manual.
- GGP Composition
- GGP Recommendation must be approved by a super majority of the GNSO Council

Mandate

- Ongoing nature vs one-time
- Complex process and long including reports and comment periods, GNSO approval...

Composition

 GGP Team must reflect the composition of the EPDP Team, in terms of represented groups, not size

Recommendation Approval

- Requires 2/3 of both GNSO houses or ¾ of one and >50% of the other.
 - One SG, plus one other House member can veto.
