
# ccTLD Delegation and Transfer Process

### **Process Overview**



#### **Initial Evaluation**

- Request is to delegate or transfer a ccTLD
  - Supplied data is clear that the request is for the full ccTLD delegation or transfer process, the supplied data is wellformed and consistent
- String Eligibility
  - The string is eligible to be delegated (or remain delegated)
- Supporting Documentation Provided
  - Our team reviews any supporting documentation that has been provided to ensure the request meets the ccTLD delegation and transfer criteria
  - We notify the requester if further documentation or clarification is needed

#### **Technical Check**

- Technical checks are identical to routine root zone change requests.
- Name Servers are responding
- Name Servers return correct data
- DNS data can be verified using supplied DNSSEC DS records
- Supplied email addresses work
- Whois and RDAP servers are valid
- Registry URL is valid

# Demonstrate Consent / Regulatory Check

- Existing contacts agree to change
- New contacts agree to their new responsibilities
- Incumbent manager provides consent that meets criteria
  - We provide a pro-forma that can be used, but is not mandatory
- Request is reviewed to ensure it meets legal requirements



# **Staff Evaluation and Findings**

- We evaluate the request and supporting documentation that may include, but is not limited to:
  - Operational and technical competencies of the proposed manager
  - Organization's legal status and geographic location
  - Chronology of community events and statements from significantly interested parties
  - Government review and consideration
  - Registration policies
  - Transfer or implementation plan
- We make a determination and prepare a report of the findings
- The ICANN Board of Directors reviews a report of our findings to ensure that the proper procedures were followed in evaluating the request.

# **Implementation**

- Technical checks are re-performed (in the intervening time during evaluation, situation ma have changed)
- The changes are implemented in the Root Zone and the Root Zone Database
