

## Topics of Interest

- •Internet Governance 80%
- Transparency and Accountability 67%
- Cybersecurity 57%
- •DNS Abuse 53%
- •Multistakeholderism 53%

- •Internet governance 14 people
- •Transparency and Accountability 9 people
- •DNS Abuse 11 people
- •Multistakeholderism 8 people
- •Cybersecurity 8 people

## Analysis Other additional comments for topics


### •Outreach and Engagement:

#### Recommendations

- Include brief background presentations on subjects of interest in every monthly meeting.
- Select specific topics and schedule them for monthly calls
  - Include project on how things work, and making that information more understandable and accessible
- Research how we can effectively reach out to new members
- Work on getting existing and new members involved in projects. All volunteers should be embraced.
