- Large number of “Can’t Live With” issues to address
 - Many conflicting
- “Deferred” not yet discussed
 - Legal/Natural, Accuracy, E-mail anonymization
- Evolution

SSAD Evolution

- Service Level Agreements (SLAs)
- Automation [and centralization]
- Third-party purposes
- Financial sustainability
- Operational and system enhancements

Evolution Mechanism

- GNSO Guidance Process (GGP) proposed by staff
 - Rejected by ALAC, GAC, SSAC, IPC, BC
- New proposal
 - New group
 - No need for GNSO or Board
 - Likely veto for Rr/Ry on matters addressing liability
 - Rejected by Rr, Ry, NCSG

“Evolution”

- Very few specific cases currently proposed for central decisions.
 - Even those in question due to recent legal advice
- Many willing to accept because SSAD could evolve
- CP now say that any change to where decisions may be made is “policy” and requires a policy process to change
 - But willing to accept a GGP, which by definition is not a policy process!!

Conclusion

- Without a viable evolution mechanism, the SSAD proposal is dead.
- Ticketing part of system useful, but a simple ticketing system is not what we designed.
- Some discussions still ongoing.
