## **ALAC Position**

- SSAD must be able to increase automated use cases that meet the recommended policy WITHOUT further policy development.
- Phase 1 Issues must be addressed in a timely manner.
  - Legal vs Natural
  - Accuracy and ARS
  - Anonymized e-mail addresses
- Financial model and affordability/accessibility
- Consumer protection priority

## **SSAC**

- Reiterates SAC101v2 and SAC111
- Rec 6: Priority Levels (Security Invest. ≠ Prio 3)
- Rec 10: Response SLAs (5-10 days for Prio 3)
- Rec 12: Reveal disclosure of Requestor
- Rec 14: Financial sustainability

# **GAC**

#### No formal statement (yet)

- Rec 5: Response requirements "The failure to deal with data accuracy requirements under the GDPR calls into question whether this recommendation achieves its intended purpose."
- Rec 6: Consumer protection
- Rec 8: CP Authorization "The failure to deal with data...", lack of flexibility to adjust to changing conditions.
- Rec 12: Disclosure Requirements "The failure to deal with data..."
- Rec 14: Financial Sustainability
- Rec 18: Evolution

# BC/IPC

"The IPC and BC support privacy protection for personal data, and privacy law seeks to strike a balance between the individual right to privacy and other legitimate interests. Unfortunately, the Phase 2 Final Report fails to strike this balance."

- Lack of Centralized Disclosure and Insufficient Mechanisms for Evolution
- Failure to Distinguish Between Natural and Legal Persons
- Failure to Address Accuracy of Data
- Inadequate Enforcement Policies
- Unpredictability (if and when...)
- Lack of reverse lookup

# Registrars/Registries

- Top Priorities
  - Protecting customer 's personal data
  - Minimizing risk
  - Priority 2 items WERE addressed
