

#### 2 - Issue Scoping

#### Title: Registration Data Accuracy Scoping Team (RDA\_ST)

Description & Scope:

The GNSO Council adopted a proposal on 21 October 2020 which recommended that a Scoping Team address the effects of GDPR on Registration Data accuracy requirements and the Whois Accuracy Reporting System (ARS), stating, "a scoping team would be tasked to, 'facilitate community understanding of the issue; assist in scoping and defining the issue; gather support for the request of an Issue Report, and/or; serve as a means to gather additional data and/or information before a request [for an Issue Report] is submitted'. On 22 July 2021, the GNSO Council confirmed the <u>formation of and instructions</u> to the Accuracy Scoping Team. The Scoping Team will be tasked to consider a number of accuracy-related factors such as the current enforcement, reporting, measurement, and overall effectiveness of accuracy-related efforts. These considerations are expected to help inform its deliberations and the development of recommendations to the GNSO Council on whether any changes are recommended to improve accuracy levels, and, if so, how and by whom these changes would need to be developed (for example, if changes to existing contractual requirements are recommended, a PDP or contractual negotiations may be necessary to effect a change).

#### Status/Health Rationale:

• This effort has been placed "On-Hold" and yet to start as a formal project.

#### **Current Activities:**

ICANN org is working with contracted parties on the data protection agreement from EPDP-P1 implementation prior to further work on the WHOIS Conflicts Procedure.

#### **Planned Activities:**

GNSO Council to consider the proposal, if and when available, and determine next steps according to the go-forward plan.

#### **Open Issues & Risks:**

This issue remains outstanding since the GNSO Council resolved to take step 1 of the go-forward plan in October of 2020.

#### **Completed in prior period(s):**

- The GNSO Council adopted the charter for the ICANN Procedure For Handling WHOIS Conflicts with Privacy Law Implementation Advisory Group (WHOIS Procedure IAG) during its meeting on 22 February 2018.
- Per the Council's past discussions, noting the current workload and activities that may impact the IAG's work, staff refrained from circulating the call for volunteers to the GNSO Stakeholder Groups until the EPDP Team completed certain milestones (e.g., delivery of its Final Report).
- During its extraordinary 23 July 2020, the GNSO Council agreed to send out a call for volunteers for a small group of GNSO Councilors, who were tasked with reviewing the Charter and providing the Council with a recommendation for next steps.
- The small team met on 26 August 2020 and agreed on a set of next steps, which were communicated in writing to the Council for its feedback.
- The Council passed a <u>consent agenda resolution</u> to begin with the first step of the go-forward plan for "ICANN org, in consultation with contracted parties, to draft a proposal for a modification to the existing Procedure based on its past experience with both the WHOIS Conflicts Procedure and the registrar data retention waiver process."
- Council letter to GDS Staff, informing GDS of ICANN org's action item based on the Council's consent agenda resolution, requesting ICANN org, in consultation with contracted parties, work to consider possible amendments to the procedure in light of privacy regulations.
- ICANN org provided an update to the Council that it has been working with Contracted Parties to prepare a proposal for a modification to the existing ICANN Procedure for Handling WHOIS Conflicts with Privacy Law. ICANN org plans to provide a status update in June 2021.
- ICANN org provided a secondary update to the Council that it has been working with Contracted Parties to prepare a proposal for a modification to the existing ICANN Procedure for Handling WHOIS Conflicts with Privacy Law. ICANN org plans to provide another status update in November 2021.
- ICANN org provided a follow-on update to the Council that it will await the conclusion of data protection agreement work related to the EPDP-P1 implementation prior to further work on the WHOIS Conflicts Procedure.

#### 4 - Working Group

Title: EPDP - Internationalized Domain Names (EPDP\_IDN)

Description & Scope:

On 20 May 2021, the GNSO Council passed a resolution to initiate the Expedited Policy Development Process (EPDP) on Internationalized Domain Names and adopt its charter. The EPDP Team is tasked with providing the GNSO Council with policy recommendations on: 1) the definition of gTLDs and the management of variant labels; and 2) how the IDN Implementation Guidelines, which Contracted Parties are required to comply with, should be updated in the future.

#### **Status/Health Rationale:**

This project <u>Status</u> was downgraded to "Behind Schedule" on 31 Aug 2022 and <u>Health</u> of "On-Target".

#### **Current Activities:**

- Updating the project plan and developing a project change request to be submitted to the GNSO Council in November 2022, with a proposal of completing the EPDP in a two-phased approach.
- Wrapping up deliberations of charter questions related to top-level variant management.
- Sending a request to the Chinese, Japanese, and Korean Generation Panels to initiate work on identifying guidelines and/or a prohibitive list of Han characters that should not be allowed as single-character gTLDs.
- Developing a working glossary list to define key terms frequently used during deliberation and recommendation drafting.

#### **Planned Activities:**

- Consideration of ICANN org input on draft Phase 1 recommendations.
- Prepare public comment for the Phase 1 Initial Report, focusing on top-level variant management related recommendations.
- Conduct data collection among contracted parties to assist EPDP Team's deliberation on second-level variant management related issues in Phase 2.

#### Open Issues & Risks:

- Deliberations of certain Charter questions depend on the critical input from external parties and additional data collection efforts.
- The EPDP Team plans to complete the work with a two-phased approach. Phase 1 focuses on top-level variant management related recommendations and Phase 2 focuses on second-level variant management. The EPDP Team plans to submit a project change request to the Council, seeking approval for the updated project plan.
- At the time the Charter was developed, it was assumed that the SubPro recommendations, particularly those relating to IDNs under Topic 25, would have been approved by the ICANN Board. The IDN EPDP is conducting its work with the expectation that the SubPro recommendations will be approved by the Board at some future date. However, it has been necessary for the EPDP Team to make assumptions about the implementation of those recommendations in order to address the Charter questions. While these assumptions are believed to be sound, the Council should be aware of the possible ripple effect or potential risk to the EPDP Teamwork in the event that the Board does not adopt the related SubPro recommendations.

- Completed the first reading of draft outcome language for Group 3 charter questions.
- Completed two sessions at ICANN75 in Kuala Lumpur.

#### 4 - Working Group

Title: PDP: Transfer Policy Review - Phase 1 (TPR\_P1)

On 18 February 2021, The GNSO Council passed a resolution to initiate a two-phased PDP to review the Transfer Policy. The PDP working group is tasked with determining if changes to the policy are needed to improve the ease, security, and efficacy of inter-registrar and inter-registrant transfers.

#### Title:

#### EPDP: Specific Curative Rights Protections for Intergovernmental Organizations (EPDP\_SCRP\_IGO)

The GNSO Council initiated this work to consider "whether an appropriate policy solution can be developed that is generally consistent with the first four recommendations from the GNSO's IGO-INGO Access to Curative Rights PDP and:

- 1. accounts for the possibility that an IGO may enjoy jurisdictional immunity in certain circumstances;
- 2. does not affect the right and ability of registrants to file judicial proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction;
- 3. preserves registrants' rights to judicial review of an initial [Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy or Uniform Rapid Suspension decision; and
- 4. recognizes that the existence and scope of IGO jurisdictional immunity in any particular situation is a legal issue to be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction."

The GNSO Council originally created a Work Track within the RPMs PDP WG, based on the Council referral of recommendation 5 from the IGO-INGO Curative Rights Protection Mechanisms PDP WG Final Report. The Addendum to the RPMs PDP Charter was adopted by the GNSO Council in January of 2020. On 19 August 2021, the GNSO Council initiated the Expedited Policy Development Process (EPDP) on Specific Curative Rights Protections for IGOs to enable the policy development of the IGO Work Track to continue without delay, considering the step to be an entirely procedural action and having no impact on the scope of work.

The GNSO Council adopted the Final Report during its Special Council meeting on 4 March 2019 and provided its non-objection to the commencement of Phase 2. The scope for EPDP Phase 2 includes (i) discussion of a system for standardized access/disclosure to nonpublic registration data, (ii) issues noted in the <u>Annex to the Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data</u> ("Important Issues for Further Community Action"), and (iii) issues deferred from Phase 1, e.g., legal vs natural persons, redaction of city field, et. al.

#### Title: GGP: New gTLD Subsequent Procedures - Applicant Support (SubPro\_GGP)

Description & Scope:

The ICANN org Operational Design Phase (ODP) Team identified a concern related to the Applicant Support topic, where the SubPro Final Report envisioned that a dedicated Implementation Review Team (IRT) would be responsible for performing substantive work; the ODP Team <u>submitted a set of questions</u> to the GNSO Council, asking whether the work required to implement Applicant Support may be beyond the scope envisioned for IRTs. The GNSO Council <u>responded</u> to the ODP Team, communicating that it would explore avenues to perform work as envisaged by the SubPro Final Report. The GNSO Council discussed and agreed that the GNSO Guidance Process (GGP) would serve as an appropriate mechanism in order to provide additional guidance to support eventual implementation efforts. The GNSO Council further agreed that the GGP should be limited to the single topic of Applicant support, with an allowance to add additional scope to the GGP subject to Council vote. The GGP Initiation Request was refined following input from Councilors and an <u>updated GGP Initiation Request</u> was shared with the GNSO Council on 24 August 2022. On 25 August the GNSO Council <u>approved</u> the GGP Initiation Request.
