


#### Introduction to ICANN At-Large



## At-Large Regional Policy Engagement Program (ARPEP)

**Goal:** Joint approach to At-Large community membership management.

Plan to strengthen engagement between At-Large staff, Regional GSE staff and ICANN's regional work and participation in policy advice activities

Program launched officially in April 2020 with calls with GSE and RALO leaders to streamline, synchronize and coordinate outreach and engagement activities.

# Collaboration with Global Stakeholder Engagement

Regional VPs advise on all ALS Applications

Regional VPs approve the RALOs yearly Outreach and Engagement Strategies (required for CROP funds approval)

RALO members participate actively in the formulation and execution of ICANN 5 year Regional Strategies

GSE and Community members participate jointly in ICANN meetings readouts

RALO members participate in Roadshow and Outreach activities

GSE and At-Large staff consult on an Ad-Hoc basis on regional issues.
