



Zoom Interpretation Feature – How-To





How does it work?





Considerations

Benefits

- Participants only need to operate one platform (Zoom.)
- Participants only need to operate one device.
- Streamlined feel.
- Improved meeting experience.

Limitations

- Feature is not available in the browser version of Zoom or for participants that dial in only.
- Hosts are unable to select a language on behalf of a participant, requiring participants who wish to speak to be mindful of their selections.

Troubleshooting

- If a participant fails to choose the language they will speak, all participants must unmute original audio.
- If a participant will listen to one language but speak another, they must switch their language selection in Zoom.



When will this feature be used?

Use Cases

- ICANN Meetings
- Regional Meetings such as DNS Forums.
- All requests to use this service should be sent to Language Services.

Why?

- Zoom's interpretation feature is still in the beta phase and under development.
- To provide this service, Congress Rental Network is providing the integration into Zoom.
- MTS and LS need appropriate time and resources to provide this configuration.

Alternatives

Regular meetings and webinars approved for interpretation will continue to be managed via teleconference interpretation.
