

### **ICANN71** to be Held as Virtual Policy Forum

The Board of Directors for the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) announced that ICANN71 will be held as a Virtual Public Meeting due to the continuing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The ICANN71 Policy Forum was scheduled to be held in The Hague, Netherlands, from 14-17 June 2021. The meeting dates will remain the same. Several barriers remain to holding and appropriately planning in-person international meetings. These include ongoing restrictions on international travel, limited flight availability, physical distancing requirements, risks posed to the local host community, and the possibility of a resurgence resulting in further lockdowns.

This action was taken in consideration of the ongoing consultation with the community and ICANN organization (org) to refine support for the key policy development efforts the community undertakes at ICANN Public Meetings. The Board looks forward to receiving the final outputs from that consultation as soon as is feasible, to allow for their application as early as the planning for ICANN71.

"Above all, the health and safety of the ICANN community, Board, and staff are the most important considerations for our Public Meetings," said Maarten Botterman, ICANN Board Chair. "As of now, there are still too many uncertainties involved with hosting a face-to-face meeting – even in The Hague, the city where I was born and would have loved to see you all. The Board believes that this is the right decision, and it gives us ample time to plan a successful Virtual Public Meeting."

ICANN org is grateful for the support and input from our Dutch and European regional partners during the planning process for ICANN71, and the org hopes to return to the region soon.

Registration will be required to participate in ICANN71, with registration opening in late March. Read more about virtual participation tools at the ICANN Public Meetings page.

Maximal Starting Repertoire Version 5 (MSR-5) for Root Zone Label Generation Rules (RZ-LGR)

ICANN is releasing for public comment version 5 of the Maximal Starting Repertoire (MSR-5: HTML, XML).

This version is upwardly compatible with MSR-4 adding one code point each to Latin script and

Devanagari script repertoire, and adding two code points to the repertoire of Arabic script. MSR-5 also

changes the Unicode base version from 6.3 to 11.0. Under the Procedure to Develop and Maintain Label

Generation Rules for the Root Zone with Respect to IDN Labels, the MSR is the starting point for the work

by community based Generation Panels developing the Root Zone Label Generation Rules (RZ-LGR)

proposals for relevant scripts. The contents of MSR-5 and the detailed rationale behind its development

On 8 March 2021, Matthias Hudobnik gave a presentation titled "Actors and Layers of the Internet: ICANN's crucial role in the Internet governance ecosystem" to 50 students at the seminar International Law at the Internet at the University of Graz. Furthermore, he emphasized on the various community programs within ICANN (e.g. NextGen@ICANN Program, Fellowship Program, etc.) and other engagement opportunities.

From **8 to 12 March 2021**, Matthias Hudobnik attended the virtual IETF 110 meeting and engrossed his attendance in the privacy sessions (e.g. Privacy Enhancements and Assessments Research Group and Privacy Pass) representing the At-Large Advisory Committee.

On **22 March 2021**, Matthias Hudobnik organized and moderated the first next generation roundtable titled "The Future of ICANN's Mandate and the Development of the DNS: Voices of the Next Generation!" at an ICANN meeting. This At-Large policy session explored the future of the Internet from an ICANN policy and technical perspective. The panel comprised former NextGen@ICANN participants, ICANN Fellows, and At-Large Summit III participants who currently work with ICANN community groups. During this ICANN 70 session, the panelists discussed the following questions:

- Should ICANN's mandate be adapted in terms of future developments in cyberspace?

  How might the DNS be changed to tackle future cybersecurity concerns?
- How can transparency and openness of PDP's within ICANN be ensured and all interested stakeholders be pick up inclusively?
