

RALOs Rules on Individual membership votes – July 29, 2020

RULES	Voting rights
<p><u>APRALO ROPs 2014</u></p>	<p>Vote by ONE person - Representative of the unaffiliated individuals.</p> <p>Section 27.5.2.6</p> <p>“All APRALO individual members (treated as a group) will be responsible for selecting their representative (when required to from time to time and or to contribute to the Regional General Assembly)”</p> <p>27.5.2.8 Selection or ratification of this representative of the unaffiliated individuals will occur whenever a new:</p> <p>27.5.2.8.1 - APAGM is called.</p> <p>27.5.2.8.2 An ALAC member is selected by the Regional Membership or Leadership elections are held.</p> <p>27.5.2.8.3 The unaffiliated individuals (as a group) will adopt a verifiable process to ensure that consensus is achieved or if required, any votes cast to follow (in general)these Rules of APRALO and if needs be any metrics or requirements to ensure that their selected representative reflects the view she held among their membership</p>
<p><u>AFRALO Operating Principles 2017</u></p>	<p>No right to vote currently.</p> <p>Article 5.11. The Unaffiliated members participate in all the AFRALO activities including but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attending the AFRALO face to face and virtual meetings, • Participating in and/or initiating debates • Proposing views, activities or projects, etc. <p>Nevertheless, they don’t participate in any kind of decision making in AFRALO</p> <p>The AFRALO Operating Principles Review Working Group is analyzing individual membership including rights to vote.</p>
<p><u>EURALO Articles of</u></p>	<p>Section 7. Membership</p>

RALOs Rules on Individual membership votes – July 29, 2020

<p><u>Association 2019</u></p>	<p>7.2. Natural Persons may apply through the EURALO Individual Users Association. One person (elected by the Euralo Individuals Association) votes within EURALO as established in <u>By laws of EIA</u> (Article 4)</p> <p>The Association’s annual General Assembly selects its representative who has a voting right at EURALO’s GA</p>
<p><u>LACRALO Rules of Procedure 2020</u></p>	<p>All Individual users shall be deemed members of a single ALS of individual members to exercise their right to participate in any kind of voting.</p> <p>Section 4. Vote by the ALS of Individual members equivalent to the weight of ALS with lower weight*.</p> <p>(*each LACRALO ALS has a “weight” according to LACRALO’s country coefficient assigned to each country.)</p>
<p><u>NARALO Rules of Procedure 2017</u></p>	<p>Vote by ONE person – Representative</p> <p>Membership - the voting body of NARALO consisting of the ALS Members and the voting representative of unaffiliated Individual Members.</p> <p>* Note 4. Paragraph 3.3 of the 2017 <u>NARALO Rules and Procedures</u> state that “Appointment of a new voting representative and alternate(s) of the Individual Members shall take place as soon as practical after each ICANN Annual General Meeting”.</p> <p>3.4 The voting representatives of active ALS Members and of the Individual Members shall have the right (i) to attend and vote at NARALO Membership meetings, (ii) subject to the provisions of Section 8* of these Rules of Procedure, to vote in elections for officers and NARALO’s ALAC Members and for NARALO’s recommendation for its NomCom Delegate, and (iii) to vote on other NARALO matters, as appropriate. Alternate voting representatives may attend meetings and participate in online discussions, but may not vote, if the voting representative is present and available to vote.</p> <p>* 8. Process for ALS Decertification and Loss of Individual member status</p>

Note : For APRALO, NARALO all the Individuals have a separate poll that they vote in, including the Representative. The result of that, no matter what the Representative thinks, is to vote in the general/ALS electorate on behalf of all Individuals.
