ICANN Mission, Commitments and Core Values

Include, among others:

- Preserve and enhance the administration of the DNS and the operational stability, reliability, security, global interoperability, resilience, and openness of the DNS and the Internet;
- Facilitate the coordination of the operation and **evolution** of the DNS root name server system;
- Introduce and promote **competition** in the registration of domain names where practicable and **beneficial to the public interest** as identified **through bottom-up**, **multistakeholder policy development**.


