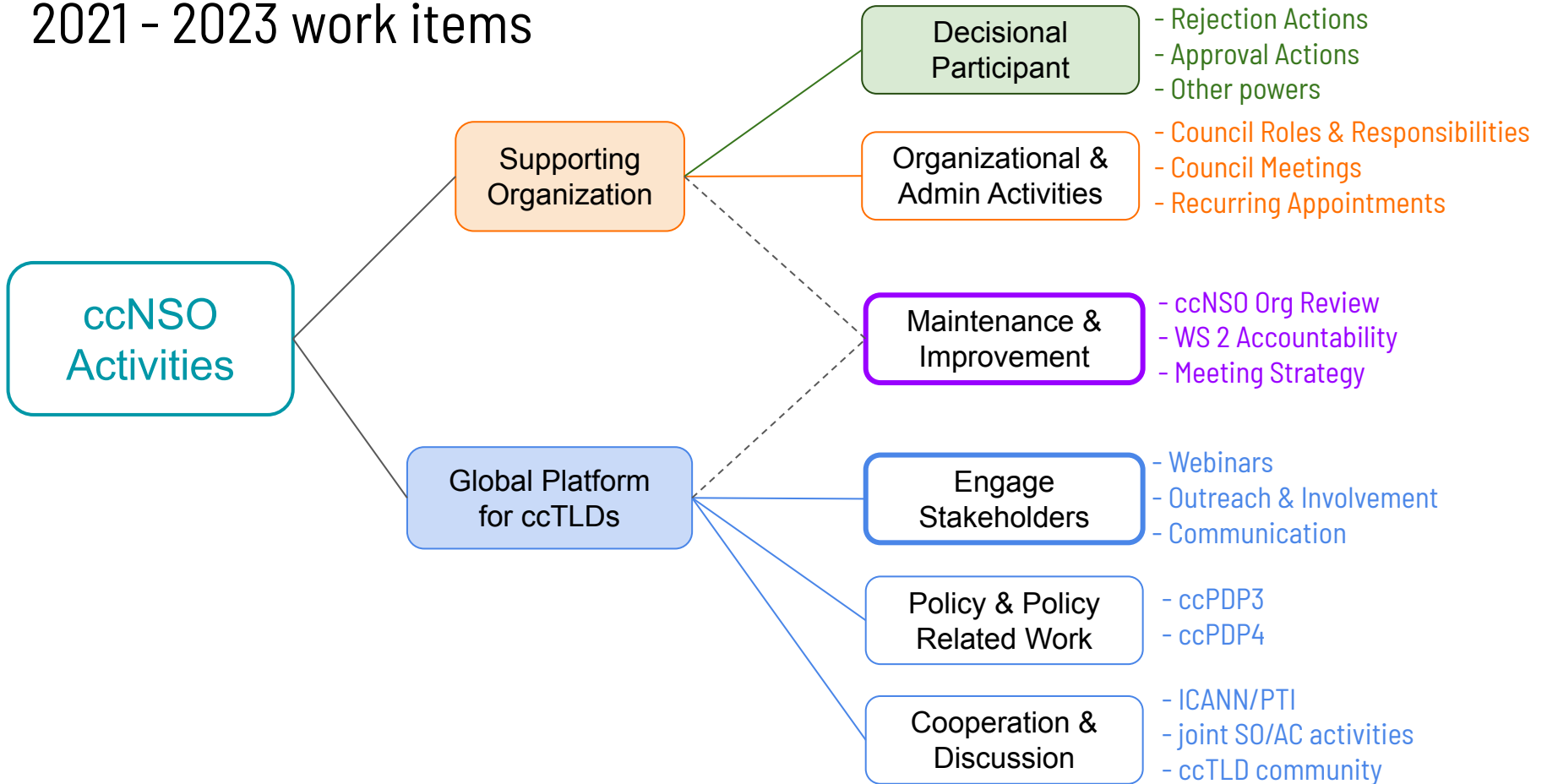

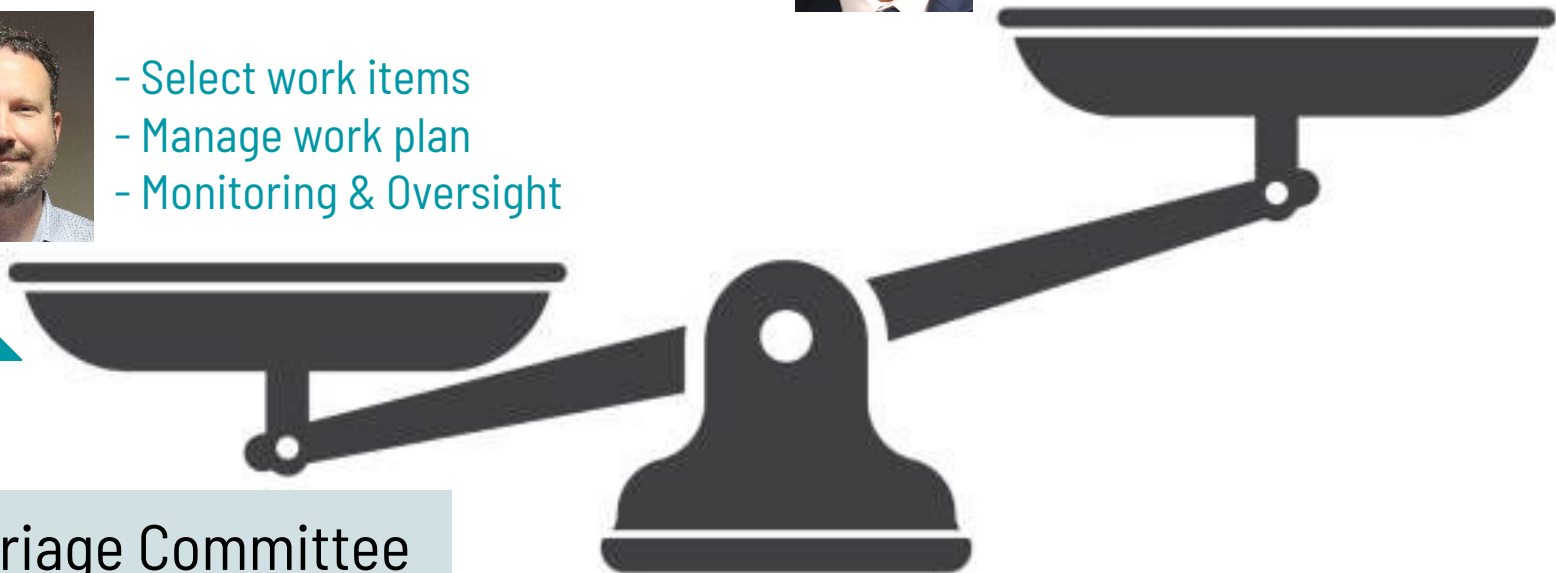

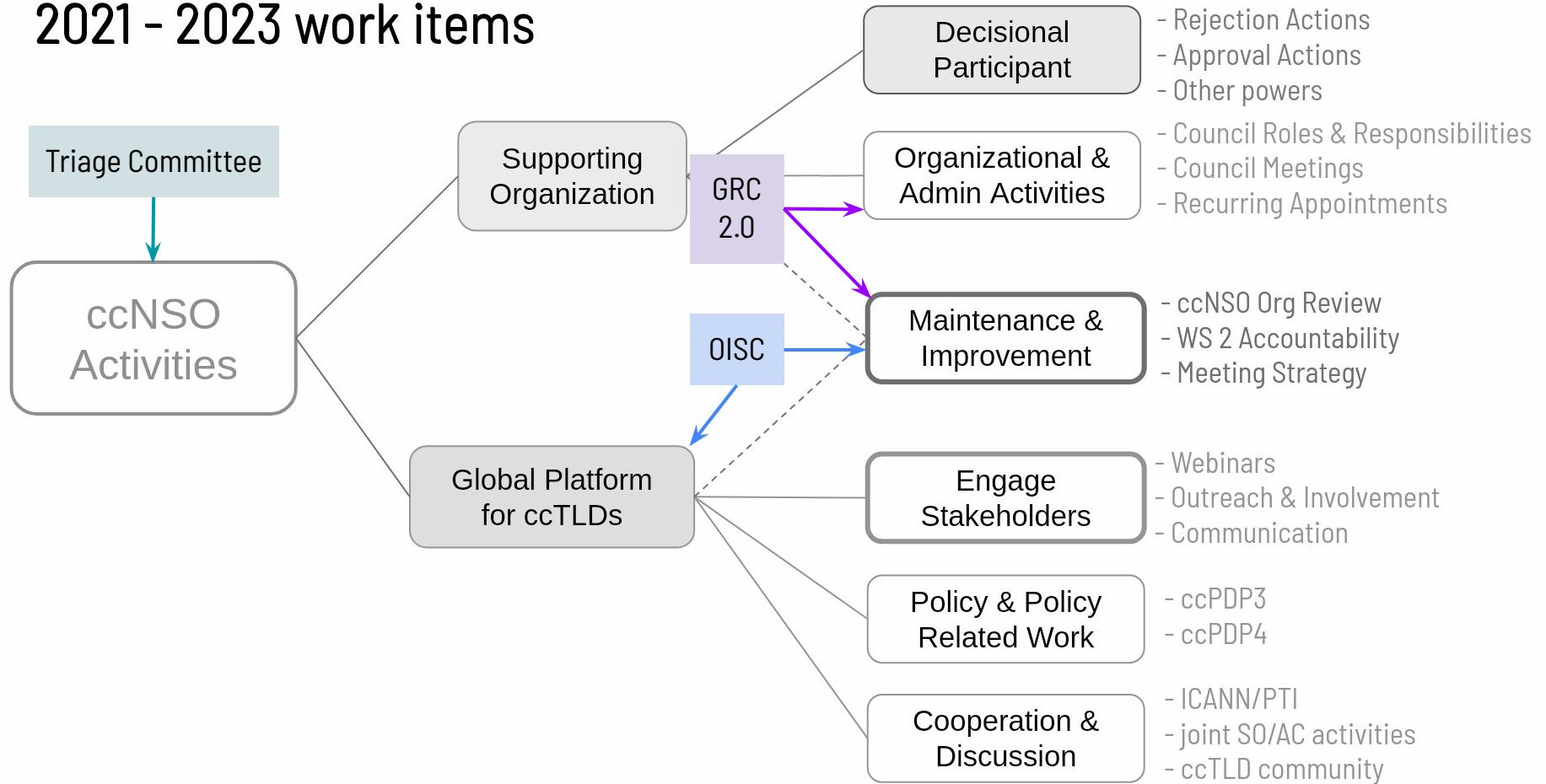

Final phase of the ccPDP3 on retirement of ccTLDs

- 3rd time in history this happens!
- Things we still need to do:
 - a. Formally separate part 1 & part 2 of the ccPDP
 - b. Make a recommendation on the proposed policy (part 1) - Final Report
 - c. Approve the Members Report
- Get our members to take action and vote in July!
 - a. ccNSO Rules:
 - 50% Members
 - 66% of votes in favor

- **ccPDP3 part 2 - Review Mechanisms**
 - For decisions regarding the delegation, transfer, revocation, and retirement of ccTLDs
 - Identified which decisions should be subject to a review
 - Explored requirements for the review mechanism

- **ccPDP4: (de)selection of IDN ccTLD strings**
 - Eventually replaces the IDN ccTLD Fast Track Process.
 - **WG will seek feedback from the broader community at ICANN71**
