MSM topics cont'd

- 7. Recruitment & demographics (connected with rep.&inclusiv.)
- 8. Complexity (cross-over with ATRT3)
- 9 Efficient use of resources
- 10 Culture, trust & silos (cross-over with ATRT3)
- 11 Roles and responsibilities and holistic review of ICANN (cross-over with ATRT3)

Prioritization of MSM topics for At Large

High:

Representativeness & inclusiveness (essential to ICANN MSM DNA);

Roles and responsibilities & holistic review of ICANN (seen as a route to addressing numerous issues and refreshing the model)

Prioritization of MSM topics for At Large – cont'd

Medium: consensus; recruitment & demographics; complexity; culture, trust & silos;

Low: costs; terms

N/A: prioritization of work, scoping, efficient use of resources

Note: this group is also prioritizing recommendations from ATRT3, CCTRT, WS2, SSR2, RDS/WHOIS2

Going forward

Goal: to use this ranking (and further info from prioritization subgroup) to focus our input to budget discussions and documents re: MSM

Objective: to become proactive rather than reactive in the budget process; to provide advance input to budgetary discussions
