Standardized/Common Data element recommendation



The EPDP Team recommends that, a field or fields MUST be created for the RDDS that MAY be used by those Contracted Parties that differentiate between legal and natural person registration data and/or if that registration data contains personal or non personal information. The SSAD, consistent with the EPDP Phase 2 recommendations, MUST support the field or fields in order to facilitate integration between SSAD and the Contracted Parties' systems.

Standardized/Common Data element recommendation



These field(s) must be able to accommodate the following values:

Legal Status

- The legal status distinction was not made.
- Unspecified Indicating the Registered Name Holder and/or registrar didn't specify.
- Registered Name Holder is a Natural person
- Registered Name Holder is a Legal person

Personal Data

- The presence of personal data wasn't determined
- Unspecified Indicating the Registered
 Name Holder and/or registrar didn't specify
- Registration data contains personal information
- Registration data does NOT contain personal information

The EPDP expects that the technical community, for example the Registration Data Access Protocol (RDAP) Working Group, will develop any necessary standards associated with such fields.

Two Data Elements Possible Approach



The use of two data elements, one for the legal status of the registrant, and one for whether the registrant data contains personal information


Legal Status (KIND)	Personal Data
000 Blank, indicating the question either wasn't asked or wasn't answered. This is distinct from the registrant declaring they won't specify.	000 Blank, indicating the question either wasn't asked or wasn't answered. This is distinct from the registrant declaring they won't specify.
001 Unspecified. The registrant says they won't say.	001 Unspecified. The registrant says they won't say.
010 Natural person	010 There is personal data
100 Legal person	100 There is no personal data

Disclosure rules:

if the registrant status is one of <a list of values>, set the disclosure rule to be R1 if the registrant status is one of <a second list of values>, set the disclosure rule to be R2 etc
