The global public interest from an ICANN perspective



The Global Public Interest:

- is linked to ICANN's mission and the operational stability of the Internet
- is context driven
- is determined by the multistakeholder model through a bottom-up multistakeholder community process

Decision making framework and board GPI framework



Broad ICANN Category	Public Interest Categories
ICANN's technical coordination	Stable, Secure, Open, Resilient, Interoperable
ICANN's role in the DNS marketplace	Competitive, Fair, Trusted
Benefit to the Internet community	Beneficial
ICANN's global multistakeholder community and policy development policies	Diverse, Respectful, Inclusive, Innovative, Transparent, Open, Balanced
ICANN's policies and practices	Neutral, Objective, Responsive, Accountable, Sustainable, Fair, Fiscally Responsible

The current framework

- helps determine how recommendations/decisions meet the public Interest
- is not part of the process through which decisions/recommendations are made
- may be used in parallel to existing processes

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Could the existing framework be utilized during deliberations as opposed to after decisions and recommendations have been made? 	Benefit to the Internet community	Beneficial
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Balancing tests would be required to evaluate the public interest categories. 	ICANN policies and practices	Neutral, objective, responsive, accountable, sustainable, fair, fiscally responsive
