- ¶1 Safer Internet, Cybersecurity and Regulation
- The growing concerns on issues such as misinformation, fake news, hate speech and harassment, online violence and terrorism, organized cybercrimes, data breaches result in a decrease of trust as well as a wave of state regulations to mitigate the cybersecurity risks. 


