

Statement Purpose and value of the ccNSO (adopted by Council in August 2020)

- The ccNSO provides a **global platform** for country code Top Level Domain (ccTLD) Managers to:
 - Undertake policy and policy related work,
 - Nurture technical cooperation and skill building, share practices and discuss topics of mutual interest and concern,
 - Engage with and be informed about other stakeholders in the ICANN environment on topics of mutual interest.
- In addition, the ccNSO is one (1) of the three (3) ICANN SOs and (1) of (5) DPs and is required to carry out related responsibilities required and mandated by the Bylaws.

Promote "one size does not fit"

Not follow the same model: very important to inform others. Need to explain so outsiders understand who to contact if needed. Vice-versa.

Messaging who needs to be contacted needs to be very clear

High Impact

It is a one size solution, to show not all are the same

List of contact points, basic information -> link to ccTLD

ccNSO doc to explain how ccTLD they can (outside)

High effort, multitude ccTLD, database, could be limited by seeking cooperation.

Medium High

Share information with other parts of ICANN

No wrong expectation very important: clarify

Share use cases reflecting the different models

Work with RO, to exchange information

Manage expectations about the role of ccTLDs & (ccTLD) registrars

Support community developed voluntary frameworks

Remind all stakeholders that ccTLDs are not gTLDs

Inviting others very impactful and beneficial for ccTLD
