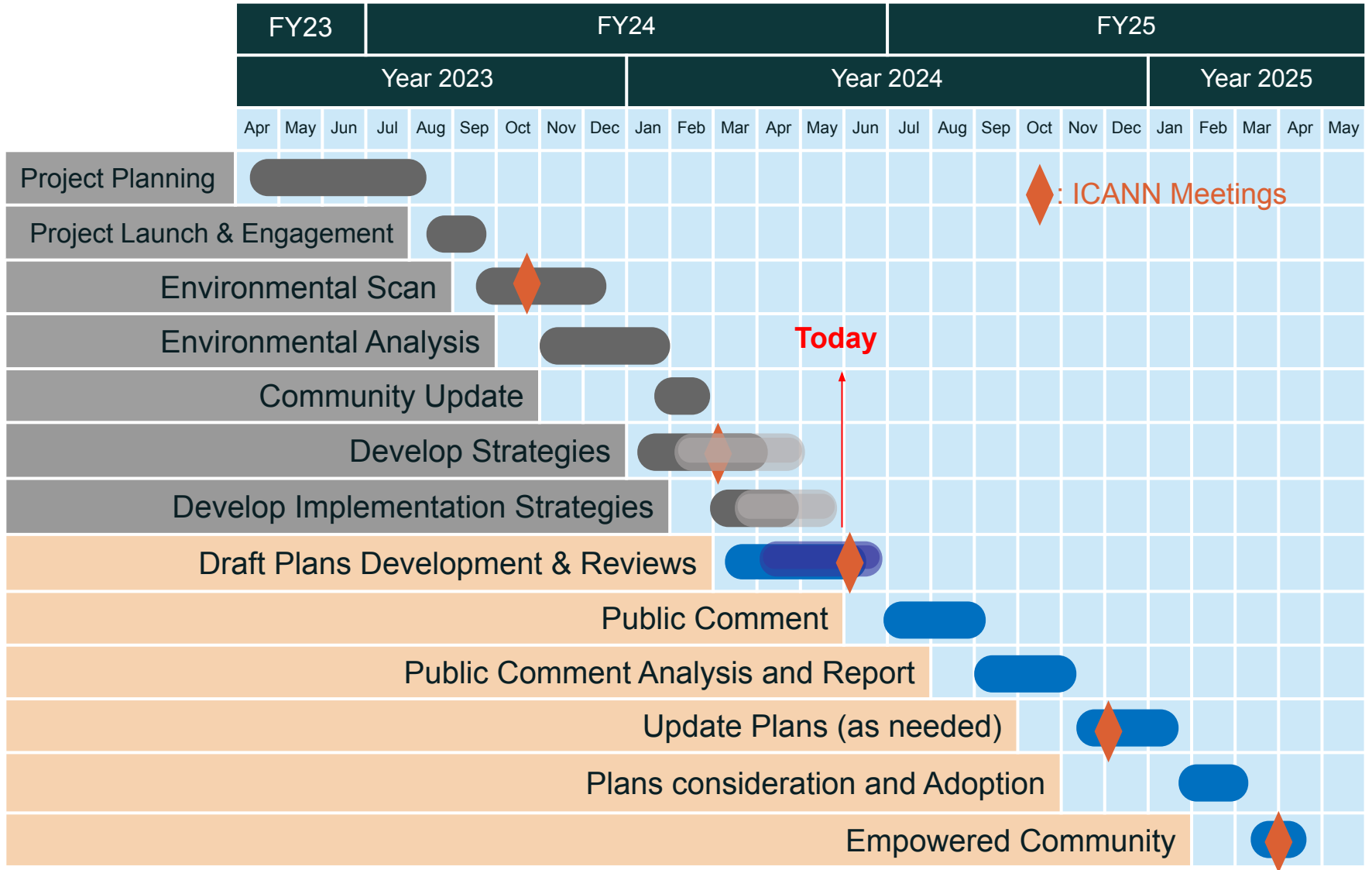

Introduction and Project status and timeline

Introduction

- The ICANN Bylaws require a five-year strategic plan for each five fiscal year period, and a five-year operating plan: both are refreshed annually
- This strategic planning process will result in the delivery of:
 - The ICANN FY26–30 Strategic Plan
 - The ICANN FY26–30 Operating Plan
- The Board Strategic Planning Committee (BSPC) is responsible for initiating and leading the strategic planning process on behalf of the ICANN Board
- The current timeline aims to deliver the FY26–30 Strategic Plan for Board consideration of adoption no later than March 2025

FY26-30 draft Strategic Objectives, Goals and Strategies

How the Board Developed the Draft Strategies

Between January to May, the BSPC held 13 committee working sessions and three Board Workshop sessions to develop draft strategies for ICANN for the next five years. Today, the BSPC, on behalf of the Board, will present these draft strategies and seek feedback from the Community



Environmental Scan

- The environmental scan provided insight on the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats that ICANN may encounter in the coming years



FY21-25 Strategic Plan

- Building on the foundation of the current Strategic Plan ensures continuity and alignment with ICANN's mission
- While the strategic objectives and goals are evolving, this provides consistency and clarity

- Current and future state review

Develop Implementation Strategies

- Workforce planning / internal alignment / integration
- Deliverables, metrics and timeline planning



Develop Strategies

- Mission, vision, values
- Core competencies
- Strategic objectives and goals

Develop Action Plan

- Plan for execution
- Resource allocation
